9. Downtown Parking

- a. Dean Olmsted of Reny's has brought forth parking concerns in the Downtown area
- b. The issue affects both employees and customers; both recognizing mobility issues for parking long distances from the store
- c. Parking has been a chronic problem over the years
- d. Dean will attend the September 12th Farmington Selectboard meeting to start an active conversation to find a common solution. Patty with attend as support, but all are welcome to attend and express their parking issues
- e. Potential options may be addressing Zoning changes, parking time limits, location changes.
- f. Patty has provided a Downtown map for Dean to use as a tool for identifying locations and general areas with the largest issues
- g. Chief Charles offered that the new parking ticket system may have some reporting tools to identify the most violated locations.
