- Please be sure to fill out and sign the enclosed Launch Form and Credit Card Form and return at your earliest convenience Due to the large quantity of land storage boats, Norwalk Cove Marina can only accommodate 50 boats a week to launch, the earlier your form is handed in the better your launch week will be honored.
- Norwalk Cove Marina will NOT schedule boat launches during the week of May 20th.
- When selecting your launch week please make sure your summer slip/mooring will be ready otherwise dockage charges will be applied after your allotted timeframe for launching has passed (Please see the back of the Launch Form for specifics).
- Make sure lines, fenders and power cords are easily accessible for the Norwalk Cove Crew to successfully launch your boat.
- If you have a ladder under your boat, please be sure to leave the combination/key with the office if we do not have the combo there is a chance your chain/cord will be cut and the ladder will be moved to storage. (Norwalk Cove Marina is not responsible for owner ladders)
- Update key locations and combos for your boat Norwalk Cove checks EVERY boat when launching to make sure
 no water is leaking into the boat upon launch (If we do not have access to the inside of the boat, we cannot check
 down below)
- Be mindful of where you park your car Monday-Saturday morning Norwalk Cove will be moving boats all day to accommodate the requested launches of our customers if boats are blocked by cars, it slows down the launching schedule.
- Norwalk Cove Marina, Inc cannot use customer supplied parts/materials for any job.
- If you have performed any significant work on your boat, it is your responsibility to communicate this to the office. (Examples replacement of AC units, seacock/thru-hull replacement, etc)
- Boats will be moved throughout the spring, it is the boat owner's responsibility to inform the Service Department if work is being done on the boat preventing it from safely being relocated on land.
- If you choose to remove your own shrinkwrap, Norwalk Cove Marina is not responsible for damage occurring with the removal of the shrinkwrap. (Only applied if Norwalk Cove Marina shrink-wrapped the boat in the fall)
- Please deposit shrinkwrap in appropriate recycling containers marked for shrinkwrap.
