| Meal Type    | Tier 1 | Tier 2 |
|--------------|--------|--------|
| Breakfast    | 1.66   | 1.66   |
| Lunch/Supper | 3.04   | 3.04   |
| Snacks       | 0.97   | 0.97   |

Remember:

- The rates listed above include the <u>temporary</u> additional 10 cents per meal and snack authorized for the period of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023, by the Keep Kids Fed Act.
- Note: All childcare providers participating in CACFP will be receiving the same reimbursement rate for the period of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023, regardless of their tiering status.
- As always, an Income Eligibility Form must be completed and submitted if a provider wishes to claim their own children when serving meals to daycare children.
- Providers may claim up to 2 meals and 1 snack -or- 2 snacks and 1 meal per child, per day.
- Federal Regulations state no provider may be reimbursed for meals served until he/she is certified and has all enrollment slips signed by the parents.
- As a CACFP Sponsor, we are limited by Federal Regulations as to how many months providers may claim retroactively. So, be sure to submit your CACFP paperwork on time (by the 6<sup>th</sup> of each month).
