When Maine CDC may call about COVID-19



1. Case Investigator calls person with COVID-19

- Learn who the person has been in close contact with
- Refer the person to community resources if needed
- Case Investigator

 Close Contacts
 Within 6 feet of person with
 COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes

2. Contact Tracer calls people identified as close contacts

- Enroll them in contact tracing for daily symptom checks
- Help them take steps to keep others safe in case they get COVID-19

An honest conversation with the person on the phone helps keep your family and friends safe.
