Our Mission

Inspired by scripture and the Church's social teaching, Catholic Charities empowers and strengthens individuals and families of all faiths by providing innovative community-based social services throughout Maine.

Adult Services

Assertive Community Treatment provides a higher level, team-based approach to mental health care for individuals struggling with pervasive mental illness.

Behavioral Health Home Services provide a multidisciplinary approach to caring for adults with mental illness, balancing both physical and mental health needs. The care team includes a nurse care manager, family support worker, clinical team leader and psychiatric and medical consultants in addition to the Health Home Coordinator.

Community Integration provides traditional case management services to eligible adults with a mental illness.

Counseling Services provides individual, group outpatient and intensive outpatient counseling for mental health, co-occurring and substance use disorder treatment. Psychiatric evaluation and medication management also offered to clients receiving services.

Opioid Health Home Services provide integrated office-based Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), opioid dependency counseling and comprehensive care management for individuals with opioid dependence disorder.

Residential Substance Use Disorder Treatment is a program dedicated to bringing health, recovery and stability to the lives of men 18 and over. St. Francis Recovery Center provides individual and group clinical counseling in a drug and alcohol free residential environment with 24-hour staff support coverage.
