BHH services support children and their families with a team that includes a nurse care manager, family support worker, clinical team leader and child psychiatric and medical consultants, in addition to the Health Home Coordinator.

Adult Services

Behavioral Health Home Services provide a multidisciplinary approach to caring for adults with mental illness, balancing both physical and mental health needs. The care team includes a nurse care manager, peer support, clinical team leader and psychiatric and medical consultants in addition to the Health Home Coordinator.

Community Integration provides traditional case management services to eligible adults with a mental illness.

Counseling Services provides individual, group outpatient and intensive outpatient counseling for mental health, co-occurring and substance use disorder treatment.

Also offered to clients receiving services:

- Psychiatric evaluation and medication management
- Specialized counseling services for those re-entering the community from incarceration or on probation
- Mental health counseling and care coordination support for refugees

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) and Medication Management Services (MMS) services are provided for individuals seeking medication supported treatment.

Opioid Health Home Services provide integrated office-based MAT opioid dependency counseling and Peer Recovery Support for individuals with opioid dependence disorder. Integrated office and community based assessment, counseling, education, nurse care management, care coordination and peer support for individuals with Opioid Use Disorder.

Residential Substance Use Disorder Treatment at our St. Francis Recovery Center is dedicated to bringing health, recovery and stability to the lives of men 18 and over. The Center provides individual and group clinical counseling in a drug and alcohol free residential environment with 24-hour staff support coverage.
