• Update on Video — CTVisit

Invites have been sent out and we are working with the help of Cara Workman at UConn to host and provide a tour at UConn's Innovation Partnership Building. Tim Liptrap will prepare a presentation on AI and Brenda Falusi will provide an overview of how to register on the CTvisit.com- the State of CT tourism website, which allows registered entities to submit their own events to the calendar. There are content guidelines and other instruction manuals online. Brenda can provide some technical support at Hops 44 during the networking event.

- Regional Committees update: Agriculture, Recreation, Arts and Culture The Arts Committee met January 12th with Cynthia coordinating. The current goal is to nail down all the cultural assets in the four towns. The Agriculture Committee has not met. The four town Rec Directors have met and are planning their own monthly meetings. Stephanie Crane of Bolton said their goal is to meet every couple of months.

Tim said the Lion's Club is doing valentines. Tim also mentioned that Amazon has a program where they will give non-profits returned items. The Lion's Club is participating in this program.

Tolland – David said the Town is planning for the Farmer's Market and adding a website for the Farmer's Market. The Town has received a permit application for recreational cannabis location. Brenda said she is working on promoting the first poet laureate in Tolland.
