P. Sawyer shared with the committee that she would like to place two more monuments on the town green. K. Walsh shared that next to the cemetery there is a monument; she also shared pictures. G. Carini believes that placing another monument at the Town Green will be cheaper than buying the flags. The commission will explore this idea more. Action: G. Carini and B. Stearns offered to look at the monument cost for the next meeting.

#### 11. Other

K. Walsh reminded the commission that the Fire Department will have its annual 9/11 ceremony on Monday, September 11, at 6:30 p.m. at the Fire Department.
