The Community Voice local cable access program aired last week in Bolton where the Transportation Study was discussed. The program is to be re-aired.

The Traffic Sim view of the Columbia roundabout is to be added to the CRCOG website.

A call-in session of the Community Voice will also occur with Joyce, Lia and Jeff speaking on the project on February 7.

RTE 6 PROJECT:

John explained that his work on the RTE 44 Corridor regulations in Bolton will likely serve as a good template for the RTE 6 corridor as well. In particular, the incentives to consolidate curb cuts and infrastructure to illicit the style of development that is being suggested. Atty. Mark Branse was willing to assist the Council if necessary with a cost to be shared between the member towns.
