The Capital Acquisition, Planning and Allocation Committee (CAPA) held a meeting on January 24, 2018 at the Board of Education Conference Room with First Selectman Sandra Pierog presiding. Also in attendance were: CAPA Committee members Robert Morra, Matt Maulucci, Scott Rich, Andrew Broneill and Carl Preuss; Administrative Officer Joyce Stille; Superintendent Kristin Heckt; Ray Boyd; and Board of Finance members Emily Bradley and Richard Tuthill.

1. Call To Order.

S. Pierog called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. Discussion on Capital Plan.

- J. Stille provided the current five year capital plan, list of items funded in FY18, and the new submitted requests for the Town and BOE. For FY19, one mil will equal \$436,000. K. Heckt reviewed the FY19 requests:
 - \$33,000 Phone System Upgrade BCS an e-rate grant is being used for part of the technology upgrade, will permit outside calling.
 - \$29,000 Maintenance/Activity Van remainder of van cost (\$10,000 in FY18 budget).
 - \$57,000 Dump Truck with Plow/Sander not needed, can coordinate with Town
 - \$47,000 Utility Truck/Plow replacement vehicle.
 - \$11,000 Auto Floor Scrubber replacement machine.
 - \$18,000 Ball Field Conditioner replacement equipment.
- R. Morra discussed the plan to provide the school system with the fire department four wheel drive truck equipped with a sander and plow. The fire department is receiving a crew cab. With discussions on shared services, the request for the dump truck will require further discussion.
- S. Pierog discussed the Town's FY19 list of capital items. The original request totaled \$1,783,860. Several items were postponed and the Town Garage addition (\$360,000) will hopefully be funded out of LOCIP funds. The list of items are:
 - \$40,000 Road Resurfacing contribution made annually, lack of Town Aid Road funding could impact the dollar amount.
 - \$125,000 Plow Truck remainder of truck cost (\$60,000 in FY18).
 - \$30,860 Natural Gas Infrastructure payment on natural gas project.
 - \$30,000 Herrick Park Field Lights funds towards replacement of original poles and lights.
 - \$30,000 Debt Service contribution towards debt.
 - \$12,000 Herrick Park Doors replacement of original exterior doors.
 - \$40,000 Highway Truck pickup replacement.
 - \$50,000 Service 134 FD partial funding for replacement.
 - \$34,000 Town Hall Painting total expected cost.
 - \$18,000 Senior Center Carpeting replacement of main room area.
 - \$50,000 Fire Truck Replacement annual contribution.
 - \$50,000 Fire Suppression/Water Supply annual contribution.

The group also discussed if any unused funds might be available to fund items.

3. Future Meeting Dates.

By consensus, the group agreed to meet at 7:00 p.m. on February 21, 2018 at the BOE Conference room.
