The February 7, 2020 meeting of the Board of Selectmen’s Facilities \& Public Safety Subcommittee was called to order by Chair, Sandra Pierog, at 11:03 AM.

AGENDA ITEM 3 - Consideration of and possible action on the report from the Energy Committee. DISCUSSION: Dziadul presented information about potential sites for town solar installations to the subcommittee members. The two prospective properties that the Energy Committee feels should be prioritized are the Firehouse and the High School, and the two proposals for installation focused on those two areas. Eremita noted that a carport at the Firehouse may be difficult due possible future construction at the site. Pierog noted that a ground-mount installation may be made difficult near the high school due to some of those lands being protected as open space. Dziadul projected that there would be 20-year savings of over $\$ 200,000$, and he recommended that the Green Bank be used as the firm to help evaluate sites and eventually bid the project. Dziadul projected that swift action may be able to produce an operable system before the end of 2020, given that the land near the high school was workable. CONSENSUS was reached that Kelly and Dziadul would follow up with the Green Bank and DEEP to learn more about feasibility on the prospective solar sites discussed by Dziadul.

The Chair adjourned the meeting at 12:15 PM.
