The Bolton Inland Wetlands Commission held its regular meeting on November 28, 2017 at the Bolton Town Hall. Members in attendance were Chairman Ross Lally, Vice James Chairman Loersch, Jane Darico, and David Ostafin. The Inland Wetlands agent Barbara Kelly was also in attendance. Ross Lally called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

- 1. **Approval of Agenda:** A motion was made by James Loersch, seconded by David Ostafin to change the agenda to begin with the jurisdictional determination for a timber harvest on Bailey Road. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Jurisdictional determination for a timber harvest on Bailey Road: Nick Zito a Forester working with the Bargers presented a timber harvest plan. Some of what was discussed was that the harvest will yield about 100 cords and will serve as preparatory thinning to improve future harvests. An access road and two crossings are in place. The landing area will be improved. No contract has been made with a logger as of yet. A winter start date is anticipated. Commissioner questions were answered. Barbara Kelly explained that she will walk the site to make note of the wetlands areas to be protected or avoided. James Loersch made a motion to make the timber harvest, as presented, an exempt activity, seconded by Jane Darico. The motion passed unanimously. This is an agricultural operation is covered by section 4.1 of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations.


