The landing area will be improved. No contract has been made with a logger as of yet. A winter start date is anticipated. Commissioner questions were answered. Barbara Kelly explained that she will walk the site to make note of the wetlands areas to be protected or avoided. James Loersch made a motion to make the timber harvest, as presented, an exempt activity, seconded by Jane Darico. The motion passed unanimously. This is an agricultural operation is covered by section 4.1 of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations.
