A. Application 2018-8 - Brett Capsha w/Mark Statchen - 31 Vernon Road -Restore existing lake wall.

Staff provided aerial photos showing the house and its proximity to the Lake. The retaining wall is right at the edge of the lake and is leaning over the water. A dock pier is very close to the wall. This is a dry stacked stone wall from the 1930s. The base stones are very large. The plan is to use the same footprint and restack the stones leaning toward the house. Free draining gravel and fabric will be used behind the wall. The vork will be done after lake draw down.

Because this is work within the wetlands, the application cannot be remanded to Staff. The IWC must decide if a permit is required, in which case the applicants must wait for a decision at the November hearing, or if this work is permitted as a maintenance right.

The work, as described, will not involve the removal or depositing of anything into the wetlands. In Staff's opinion there is minimal chance that an excavator will be required to dig a new footing. The contractor has probed the lake bottom right near the wall and found it to be rocky.

**Motion:** I make a motion to deem application 2018-8 to be a non-regulated activity per right according to Section 4.1d of the Inland Wetlands regulations of non-significant impact. The Inland Wetlands Agent will check that the activities are being carried out in the field as outlined in the application.
