Museum Passes

Bentley Memorial Library is now offering online museum passes! You can access the passes from the library's website from home, in the library or on your phone. Simply open the 'Museum Pass' tab and click 'ONLINE MUSEUM PASSES'. Once you arrive on the reservation page, select your museum and date. The site will show 'request' if the pass is available and 'BOOKED' if the pass is already reserved for that day. Once you have selected your museum and date, fill out the brief form with your name, phone number, email address and library card number (no spaces). Follow the prompts and you can review your

reservation and either print it or choose 'view and send pass information'. This will give you the option of receiving the pass as an email or a text message. With this new pass system, you will not need to make a special trip to the library, and you can reserve a pass even if Bentley is closed. Also, you won't need to leave a \$20.00 deposit.

There are three museums that still require a visit to Bentley to pick up a pass or coupon. For the CT Science Center, the CT State Parks and the Springfield Museums, you can request and reserve your pass/coupon through the TixKeeper program. However, you will need to come in and pick the pass up at the library before visiting.

If you have any questions, or would like a tutorial, contact a staff member at the library.

Bentley is pleased to offer coupons for reduced admission to the Connecticut Science Center. While not part of our museum pass program, these coupons offer 20% off general admission for up to 4 people. Just stop by the library to pick up a coupon.
