BENTLEY MEMORIAL LIBRARY COVID-19 Update / March 26, 2020

Beginning Monday, March 30, we will offer limited borrowing service to BOLTON RESIDENTS ONLY with a valid library card (see below to obtain or renew a card). Please be aware this is at your own risk; we cannot guarantee that items are virus-free.

CHECKOUT:

Patrons may request material by calling us at **860-646-7349** during the hours of 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday, or by e-mailing <u>bentley@biblio.org</u> or placing a hold through our online catalog at <u>http://bentley.biblio.org</u>. Limits will be placed on NEW items – two new DVDs and two new books, but for older items our normal policy will apply.

We will contact you when materials are ready to arrange a pickup time. When you arrive at the library we ask that you call us from the parking lot, at which time we will place items outside for you to pick up. Please respect social distancing and do not congregate at the front door.

The library staff will renew expired library cards and issue new cards with an expiration date of June 30, 2020, so that patrons can check out material and access online resources.

RETURN:

The bookdrop will be open for returns, but we will be using a new procedure to keep library staff as safe as possible. Items will be in quarantine off-site for a minimum of four days before being checked in. This means returned items may still appear on your account after you return them. Do not be alarmed! We will not be charging late fees on any circulating items, and there will continue to be a grace period after the library returns to normal services.

As you can appreciate, the current health crisis means that everything can change overnight. We are constantly monitoring the COVID-19 situation and re-evaluating our response.
