- **Computer Use:** by appointment only for 30-minute time period. *You must be able to use a computer without assistance;* it is not possible for us to social distance and instruct.
- ▼ Ring the doorbell upon arrival: the doors will be locked.
- Any patrons feeling unwell are asked not to come.
- ✓ All patrons must adhere to the 6-foot social distancing guidelines.
- → Hand sanitizer available upon entry. Please use it before handling library materials.
- ✓ All library materials must be returned to the <u>outside</u> book drop.
