#### **Library Reopening Update**

The library is in the planning stage for a "soft" opening at a date still to be determined. We are studying safety recommendations from the state and the American Library Association, and acquiring PPE supplies. The town's Buildings and Grounds crew has been extremely helpful (as always), including building a plexiglass shield around the circulation desk.

**Outside Pickup:** In the meantime, we will continue our outside pickup service, which we have offered since March 30. If you haven't used this service yet, please do so! Reserve your items through our online catalog (<u>Bentley.biblio.org</u>) or contact us at 860-646-7349 or <u>bentley@biblio.org</u>. We'll place your items outside for you to pick up during the hours we are working in the building. **Returns:** Our book drop is open; returned items are removed to an off-site location to quarantine for one week before being checked in here.

**New (Old) Hours:** Beginning Monday, June 15, the staff will return to working our normal hours: Monday– Thursday, 10 a.m. – 8:00 p.m., and Saturday, 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. The building remains closed to the public at this time, but a member of the staff will be available to assist you by telephone or email, and outside pickup will be available.

**Home Delivery:** And don't forget that we offer home delivery to Bolton residents who are permanently or temporarily homebound due to disability or health problems.
