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SCRAP METAL PICK UP - FIRST FULL WEEK OF MAY (MAY 1ST-5TH)



Curbside scrap metal collection will be held the week of **May 1-5, 2023**. Items for collection **must be curbside by Sunday Night April 30th**. If your items are not collected by Friday afternoon, please call the selectmen's office. Noncombustible items such as appliances and other metal items weighing up to 100 pounds are acceptable. Gas grill propane tanks need to have the caps removed. Unacceptable items include motor vehicle parts, machinery, and items weighing more than 100 pounds. Please remember this collection is for scrap metal only, not for bulk waste.

PAPER SHREDDING EVENT

Saturday, June 3, 2023



The Town of Bolton will hold its annual Shredding Event - **Saturday, June 3**, from **9 a.m. to noon** at the recycling/transfer station. Residents from the Town of Bolton can bring documents for shredding to the recycling center. All rings and binders must be removed. Staples do not need to be removed. There is no limit to the quantity of documents to be shredded.

HOMEOWNER'S TAX CREDIT - REMINDER

This is a reminder that, if you have not already, you must apply in person for the **Homeowner's tax credit by 4:00 pm, Monday, May 15, 2023.** Your application must be submitted in person at the Assessor's Office. If you cannot appear in the office, a person acting on your behalf may be approved by the assessor. **Please call 860-649-8066 x6100** to make an appointment and to advise the assessor if someone else is applying for you.

You will need to bring proof of all income received in the calendar year 2022:

- If you file a Federal Income Tax Return, bring a copy of the 2022 return and a copy of the SSA-1099 from Social Security.
- If you do not file a Federal Income Tax Return, bring copies of ALL income statements for calendar year 2022, including Form SSA-1099 from Social Security, wage and pension statements, statements from your bank(s) showing total interest earned, et cetera.

If you are under a doctor's care and are not able to file in time, you may request an extension of time to file. The request must be received by 6:30 pm, Tuesday, August 15, 2023 and be accompanied by a physician's note.

RENTERS REBATE PROGRAM

The Assessor's Office is accepting applications for the 2023 Renters' Rebate Program. This is a state program that the town administers. The program is for low income renters 65 years of age or older and for renters under the age of 65 who are receiving Social Security disability payments. Household incomes for 2022 must have been under \$40,300 (single) or \$49,100 (married). The basic requirements are that you have lived in Connecticut for at least one year and have proof of your rent and utility payments. The application period is **April 1 - October 1.** Checks are mailed to eligible renters after October 1.

The 2022 necessary documents require to process your application are:

- Social Security 1099 form for
- 1099 forms for pensions, dividends, interest, et cetera
- Employment information (W-2 form)
- If filed, complete copy of your tax return
- SSE (if applicable) letter from Social Security stating the full amount received from January - October 2022

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- Proof of all rental payments in 2022 (January - December 2022) in the form of canceled checks, rent receipts or letter/ledger from landlord.
 - Proof of utilities paid in 2022 (January - December 2022). Contact the utility company to receive an itemized report of what was actually paid. Qualifying utility expenses include electric, gas, oil, propane, kerosene and water. Call the Assessor's Office with any questions: 860-649-8066 x6100 or email assessor@boltonct.org.

BOLTON SCHOLARSHIP FUND—DEADLINE APPROACHING!

Scholarship applications are now available on the BSF - [website](#).

Deadline: Tuesday, May 9, 2023, 11:59 p.m.

Eligibility: Open to (1) any current senior at BHS planning to attend an accredited postsecondary institution in the fall of 2023; (2) any graduate of BHS who will attend a postsecondary institution (including graduate school) in the fall of 2023; (3) anyone who has been a Bolton resident for at least six months and will attend a postsecondary institution (including graduate school) in the fall of 2023.

FAQ: Are Columbia and Choice students eligible? Yes! All BHS seniors, whether from Bolton, Columbia, or Hartford, are encouraged to apply.

Are students attending East Catholic or another school outside Bolton eligible? Yes, if they have lived in Bolton for at least six months and will graduate high school this June.

Are students who will be attending graduate school/technical school/community college/certificate programs/etc. eligible? Yes, as long as they meet the BHS graduation or Bolton residency requirements and will be attending an accredited postsecondary school.

Are late applications accepted? No applications are accepted after May 9. Any that are incomplete as of the deadline may be rejected.

When are scholarship decisions announced? Scholarships for BHS seniors will be announced at the BHS graduation in June. All other recipients will be notified by mail in mid-June.

When are scholarships paid out? Award checks are sent directly to the recipient's school in early-to-mid July.

We welcome images that celebrate Bolton's unique environment and natural beauty!

Photograph a colorful morning sunrise or an evening sunset over Bolton Lake. Look for birds or other wildlife to photograph while enjoying a hike through Bolton's Freja or Herrick Park. Take a photo overlooking the valley from Bolton's Heritage Farm. Share a photo of your most effective energy saving idea or any active farming or gardening in town. Bolton offers so many beautiful places and opportunities to capture an image. All it takes is getting out there to find it!

What to enter/ Where to send: Only digital photos, no hard copy photos will be accepted. Landscape (horizontal) photos are preferred (for calendar use), but vertical images can be sent too. Photos must be taken in the Town of Bolton. Images should be of appropriate subject matter, sharp and in focus, good exposure and have a balanced composition. Image resolution should be at least 300 dpi.

Submit digital photos to BoltonPhoto@aol.com (jpeg format preferred). Each image must include photo identification.

Include photographer's name, address and phone number along with the photo location.

Specify the photo category for your image and give it a title. Example: "Evening Sunset over Bolton Lake" - The Beauty of Nature & Wildlife

any season/year)

- 1) Examples of Green Living & Farming
- 2) Beauty of Nature & Open Space
- 3) People in the Environment
- 4) Wildlife in Bolton

Prizes will be awarded to the top three photos in each category

Winners may also be featured in the Bolton- "A Town for All Seasons" 2023-2024 Calendar!

We anticipate that all prizes will be awarded at Bolton's Family Day event.

Contest Rules

1. Photos must depict the Town of Bolton.
2. Eligibility: Open to the public, even non-residents (*Conservation Commission members are not eligible*).
3. Photographs must be submitted by the photographer or include written permission.
4. All entries become the property of the Town of Bolton Conservation Commission, with shared rights for unlimited reproduction in print, electronic publications and promotional materials for an unlimited period of time. Published photos will be given photo credit.
5. You may submit up to three photos per category (max. 12 photographs).
6. Entries can be submitted in either color or black and white. (*jpeg format preferred and at least 300 dpi or greater*).
7. Each image submitted must include the photographers name, address, phone number and location, along with the specific category and photo title.
8. Be prepared to provide the Bolton Conservation Commission with written consent of anyone who appears in the photograph.
9. The Conservation Commission and selected judges look for images sharp in focus and exposure, balanced in composition and show originality and creativity. All decisions by the judges are final.
10. The Bolton Conservation Commission reserves the right to add or adjust photo titles and any prizes and/or deadline(s) as the result of causes beyond its immediate control.
