NEWS FROM THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE RENTERS' REBATE PROGRAM

The Assessor's Office is accepting applications for the 2022 Renters' Rebate Program. If you are new to the Renters' program, please call us to see you if you qualify. Below is a list of information that is required in order to process your application. This is a State program that the Town administers.

Please note that if you do not provide these documents your application cannot be processed.

Necessary documents:

- Social Security 1099 form for 2021
- 1099 forms for pensions, dividends, interest and etc. for 2021
- Employment information (W-2 forms)
- · 2021 Taxes- complete copy required if you file taxes
- SSI (if applicable) letter from Social Security stating the full amount received from January –December 2021
- Proof of all rental payments in 2021 (January December 2021) in the form of canceled checks, rent receipts or letter/ledger from landlord.
- Proof of utilities paid in 2021 (January December 2021). Please contact the utility company to receive an itemized report of what was actually paid. Qualifying utility expenses include electric, gas, oil, propane, kerosene, and water.

Please see below for frequently asked questions and the best ways to pay your tax bill.

Tax Bills will be mailed at the end of June and will be due and payable on July 1, 2022. They will need to be paid by August 1, 2022 to avoid interest. Interest accrues from the July 1 due date at 1.5% per month or 18% per year. Minimum interest charge is \$2.00 per bill

Real Estate and Personal Property Tax bills are being sent out using a temporary mill rate. A supplemental tax to these bill will be mailed out at a later date.

Motor Vehicles in which the registration expired before Oct. 1, 2021 and was not renewed until after that date will receive a tax bill in January 2023.

If you do not receive a tax bill please check online through the TAX BILL LOOKUP or call our office.

Failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the tax or any interest charged should the tax become delinquent.

Payment Options:

Option 1: Online- Save time and pay from home and receive your receipt of payment directly to your email.

You may pay by credit card or electronic check over the internet. A nominal fee will be charged by our vendor, Invoice Cloud and is non-refundable.

Credit Card/Debit Cards are not taken in the Tax Collector's Office.

Online payments will take 3-5 business days to process. The account will not show as paid online until after this processing time. Please make sure you receive a confirmation to your email that shows your payment is starting to process.

Please make sure you enter the correct account number and routing number so that the transaction does not get returned. Additional fees will be added to any payment that is returned unpaid.
