

Dog Licensing Information

Dog licensing is required every year starting June 1st. Payments can be made by **MAIL, DROP BOX** or **ONLINE** only.

Online Registration: For your convenience we are offering an online way to pay for your dog license through our View Point Cloud Permitting system. Please follow this link and then click on the Town Clerk Dog Licensing module to complete your renewal. In order to use the online system you must be able to upload your dog's current rabies certificate to complete the transaction.

Payment by Mail/Drop Box Instructions

You can license by mail or drop box if you prefer, so we would like to remind everyone that you will need the following in order to get your dog licensed:

- 1. Current rabies certificate and proof of spay or neuter is required in order to get your dog licensed.** Please enclose a copy or the original. The certificates will be returned to you with your dog's license.
- A **CHECK** made payable to the **TOWN OF BOLTON** for the following fees:
 - a. Spay or Neuter = \$8.00
 - b. Male or Female = \$19.00
 - c. Dog penalty fee = \$1.00 per month for every month late after June 30th 2021, in addition to license fee. Penalty fees becomes due starting on July 1, 2021.
 - d. Transfer from Town to Town for licensed dogs = \$1**

*** If you are new to town and have your dog licensed currently (as of June 1st 2021) in your prior town, then you need to transfer the license to Bolton within 30 days of your move. Please send in your dog's tag and license from the prior town, along with \$1, and we will license the dog and issue you a Bolton dog tag by mail.*

3. Enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope, so that we may return the license(s) to you. Please make sure to enclose a large enough envelope to accommodate the amount of tags needed for your pet(s). **Tags will not be returned without a self-addressed stamped envelope.** Because of the current pandemic there are a limited amount of funds for postage to accommodate every dog in town that is licensed.
