- 4. Public hearing to amend Schedule IV of Title 10 isolated stop signs by adding Sprague St westbound at Winthrop Avenue.
- 5. Public hearing to establish a temporary municipal parking lot during redevelopment construction and for snow emergency purposes at the McKinley School. The lot to the left of the basketball court and the lot at the rear of the McKinley School shall be striped accordingly. This will provide

business patrons and residents of this area with options for parking at the congested lower end of Yeamans Street.
