Senior/Surviving Spouse or Minor Tax Exemption Clause 17D is purely "Asset Based" and does not consider personal income. To qualify, the applicant will need to document:

AGE: Applicant is at least 70 years of age as of July 1, 2023.

OR

SURVIVING SPOUSE: Spouse deceased prior to July 1, 2023.

OWNERSHIP: Surviving Spouse or Minor owns the property in Revere as of July 1, 2023. Senior owns the property in Revere for not less than five years.

<u>DOMICILE:</u> Surviving Spouse or Minor has occupied the property in Revere as of July 1, 2023. Senior occupies the property in Revere for not less than five years.

ASSETS: Assets of applicant is less than \$ 77,857
