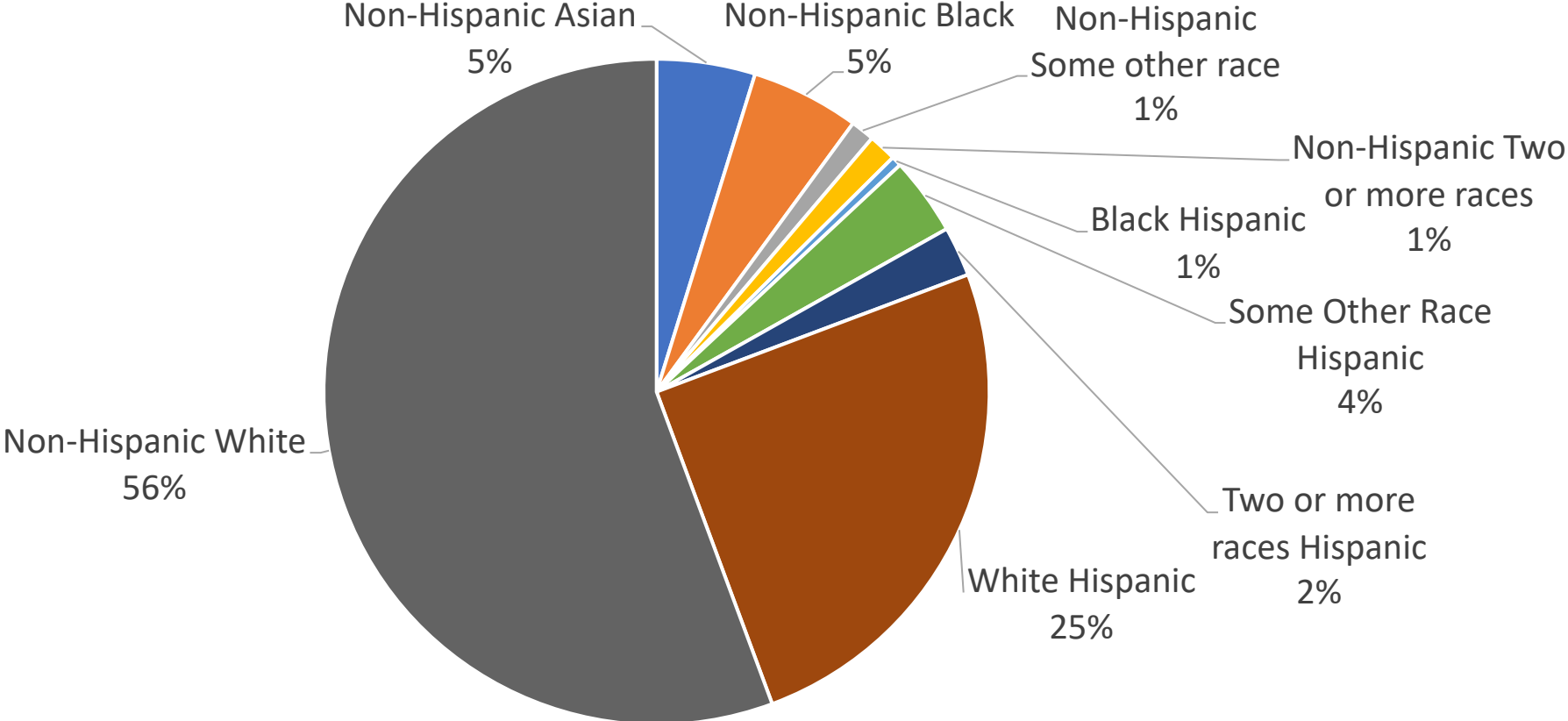
Non-Hispanic/Latino by Race

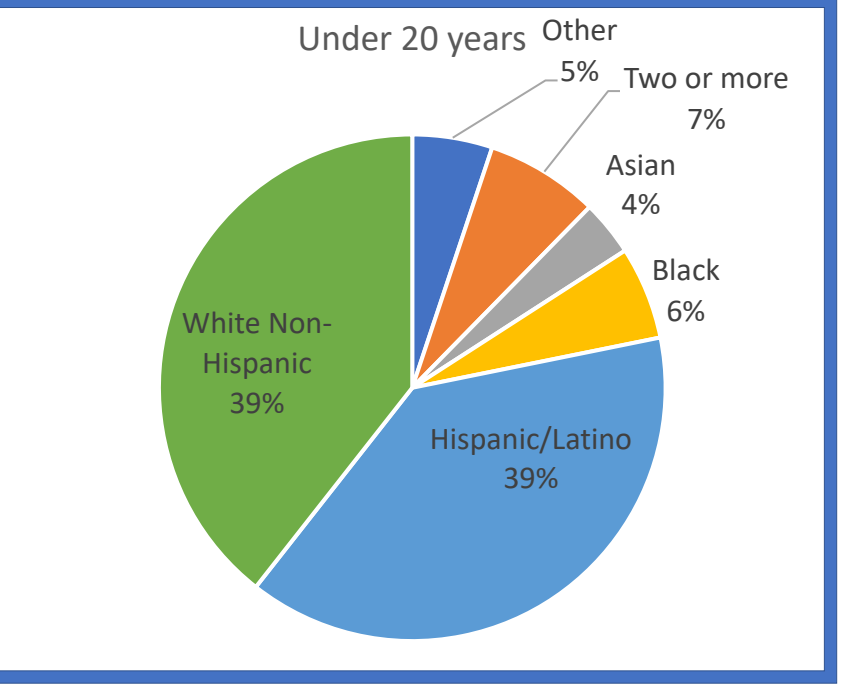
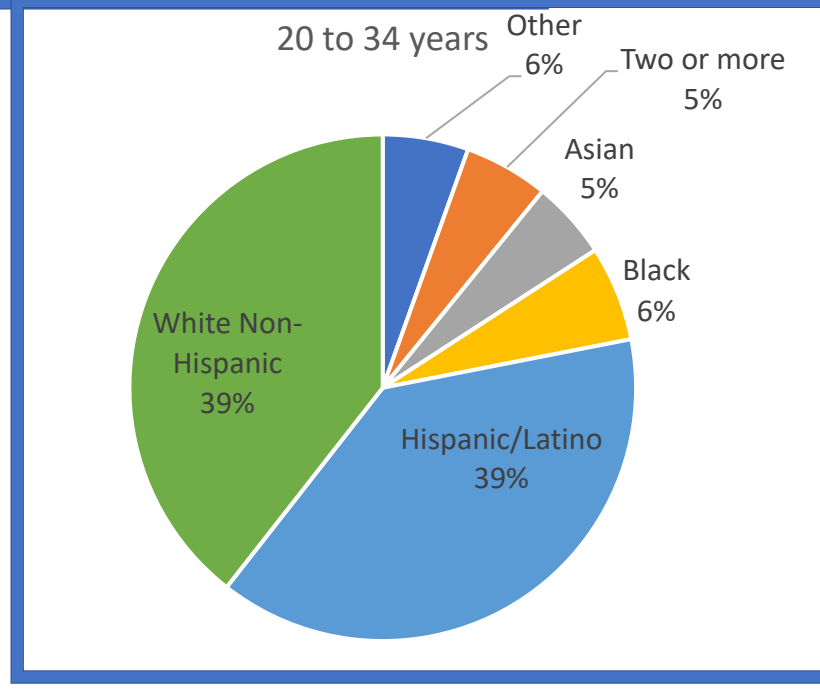
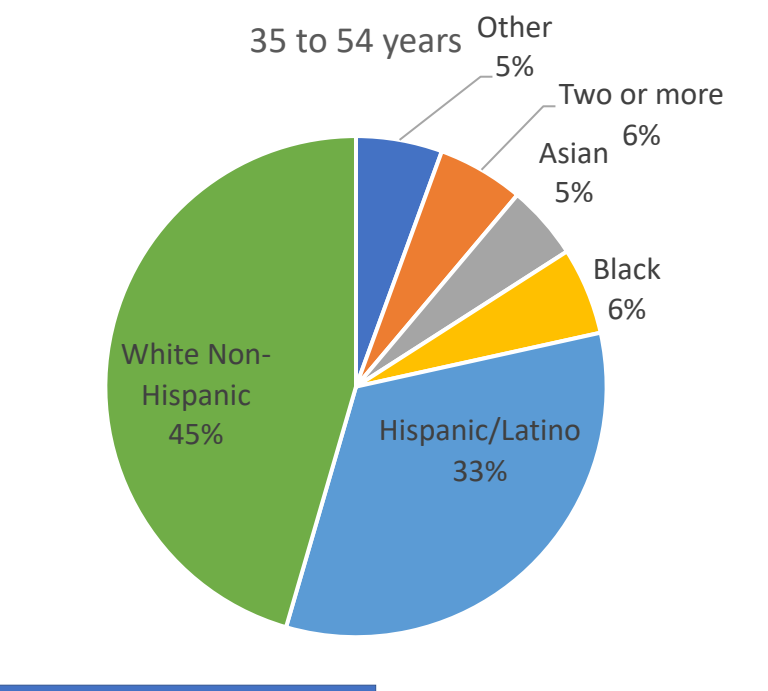
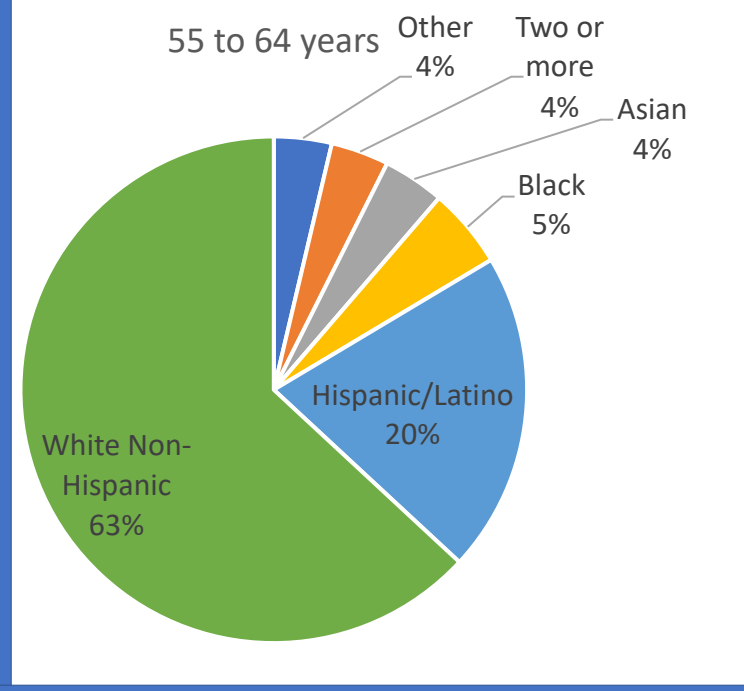
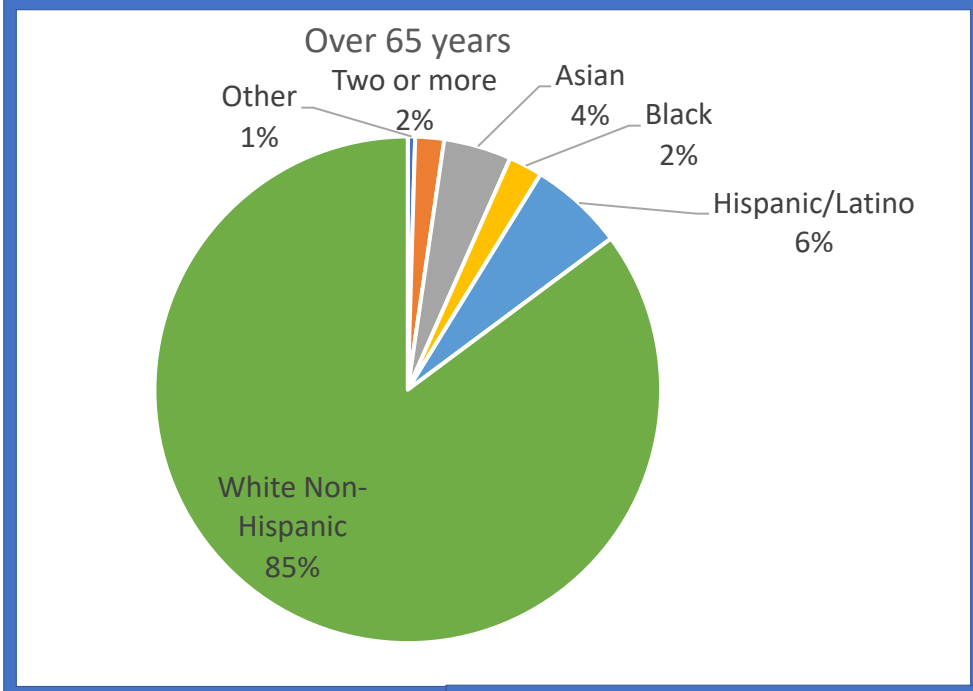


Hispanic/Latino by Race

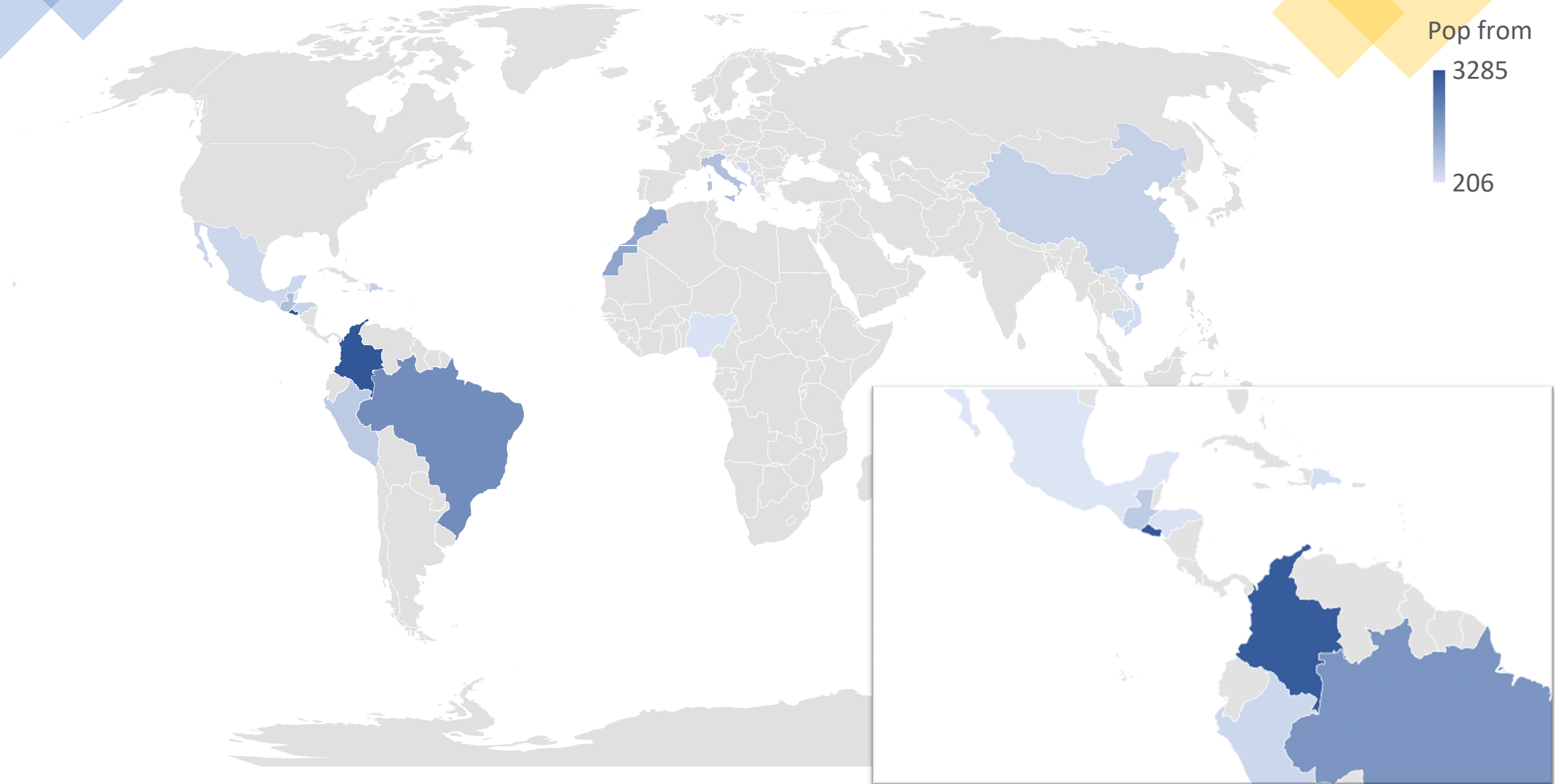

Country of Origin for Foreign-Born Residents



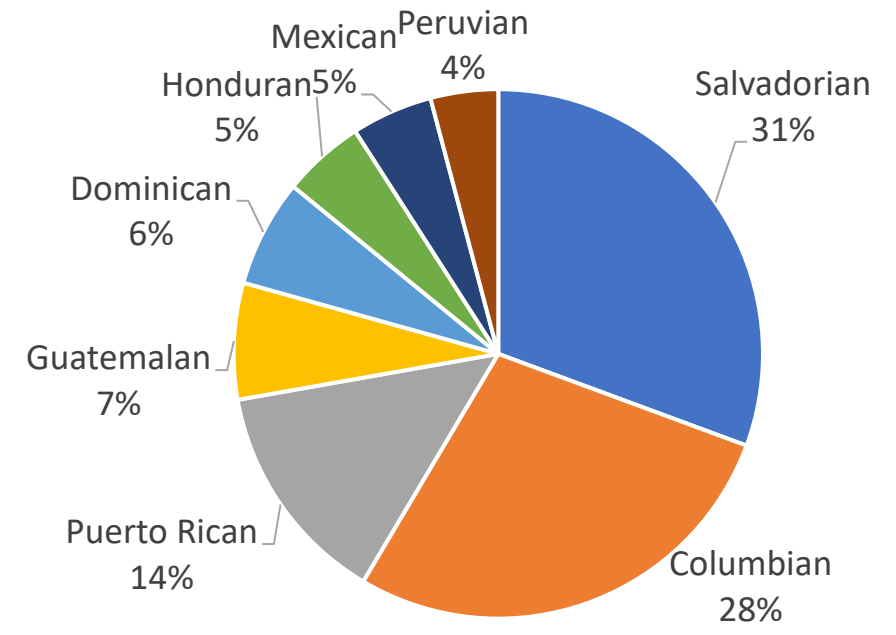


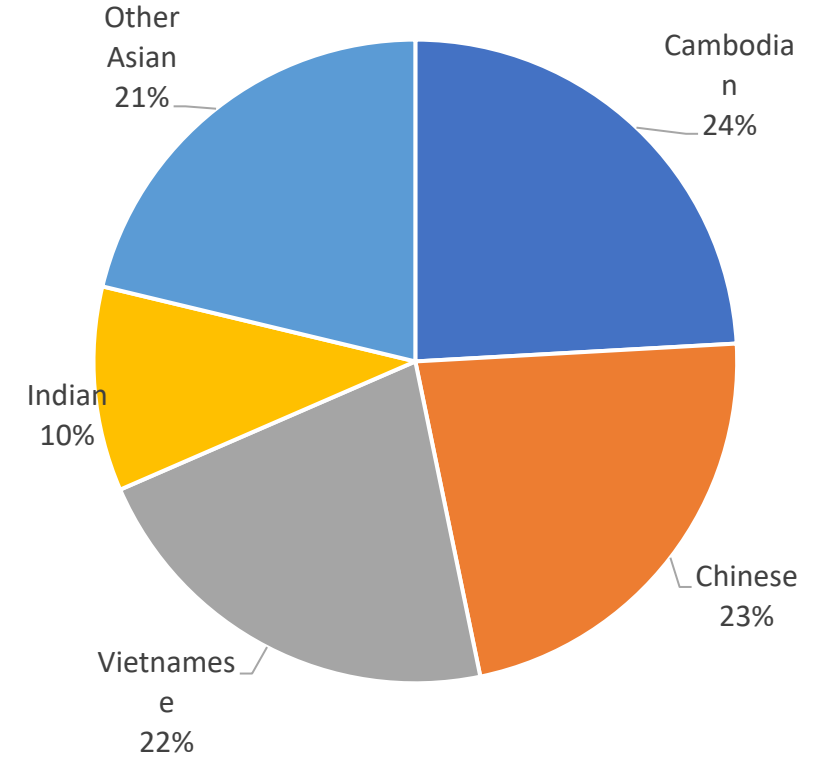

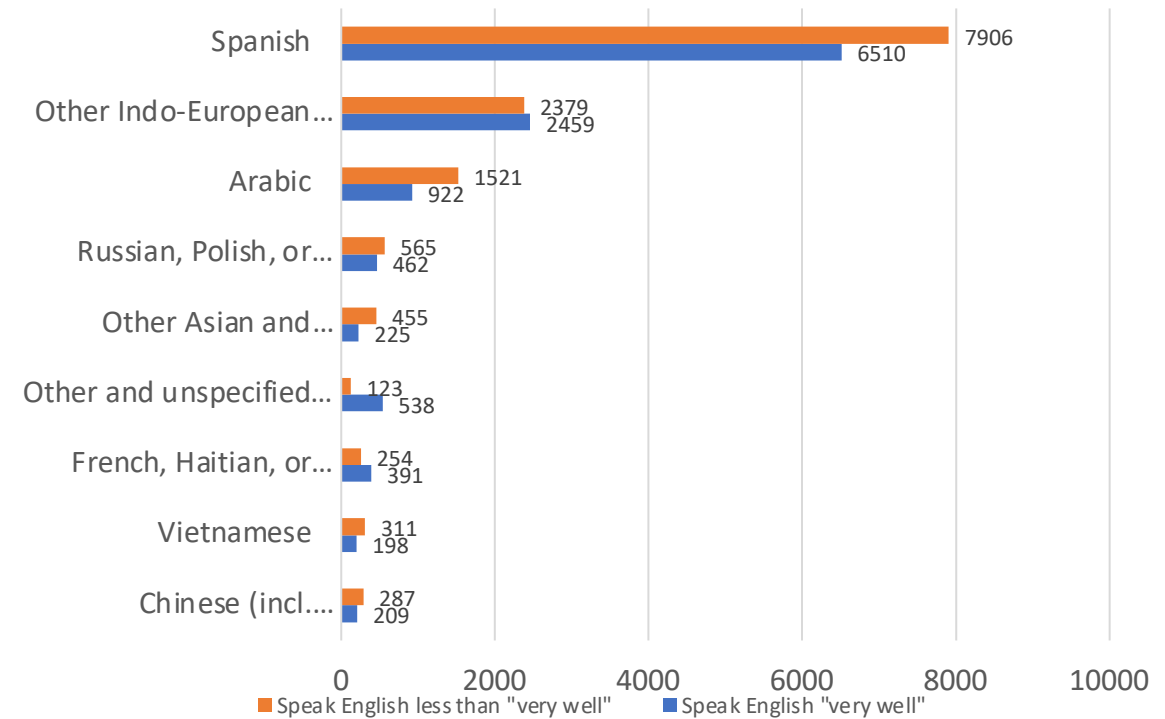

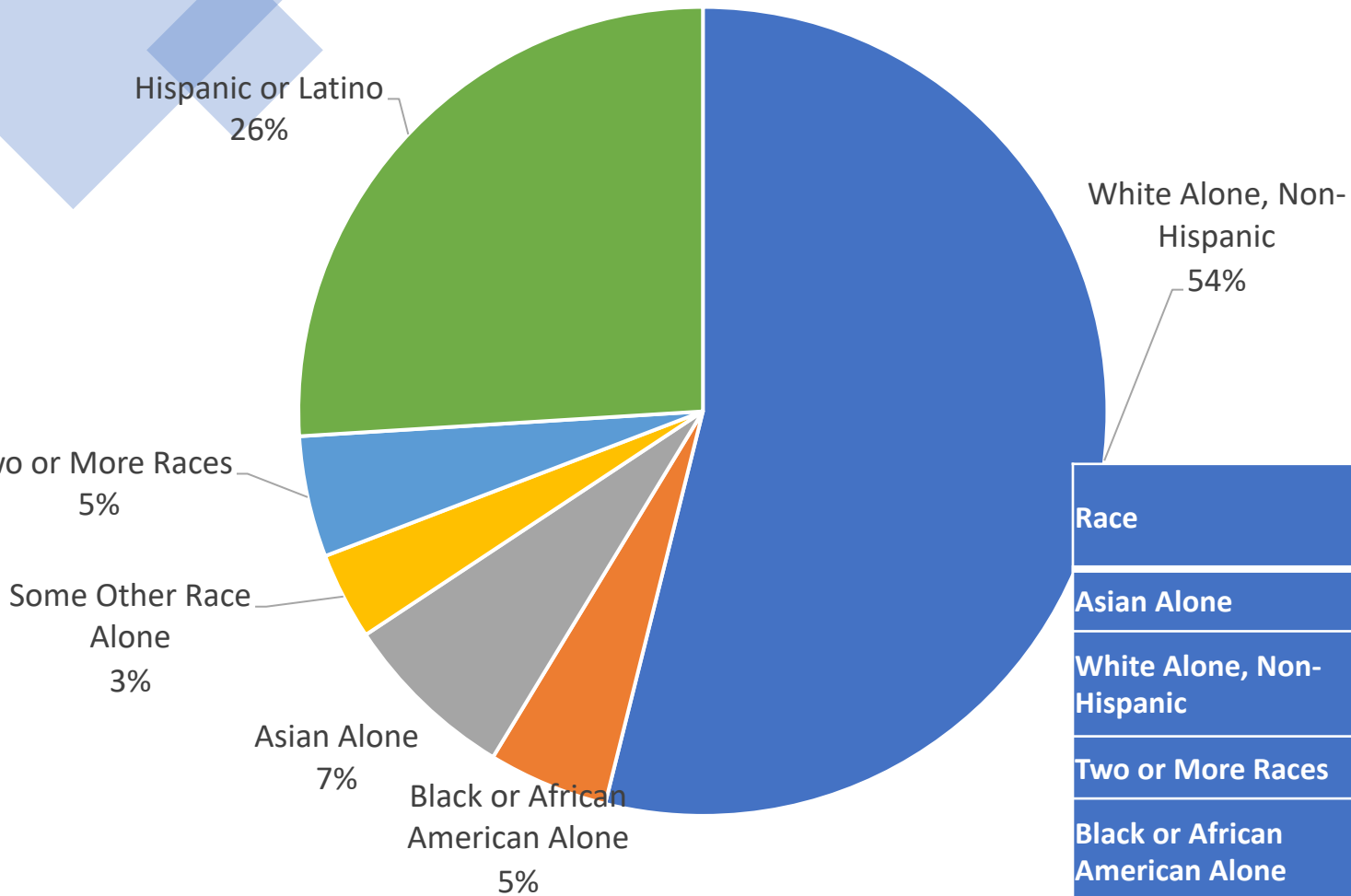

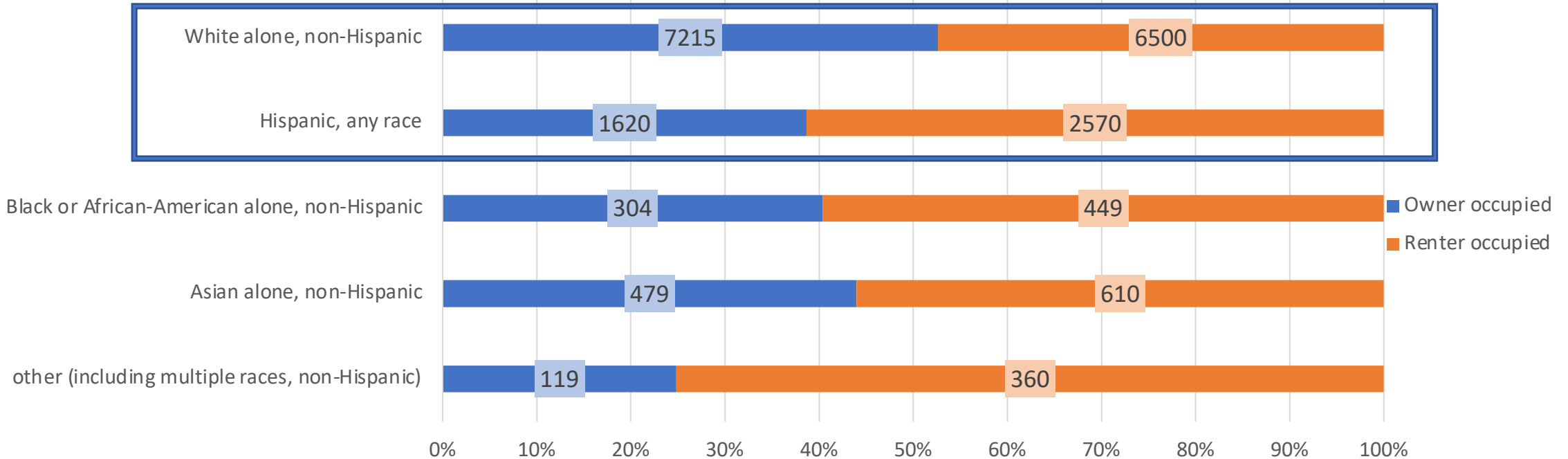

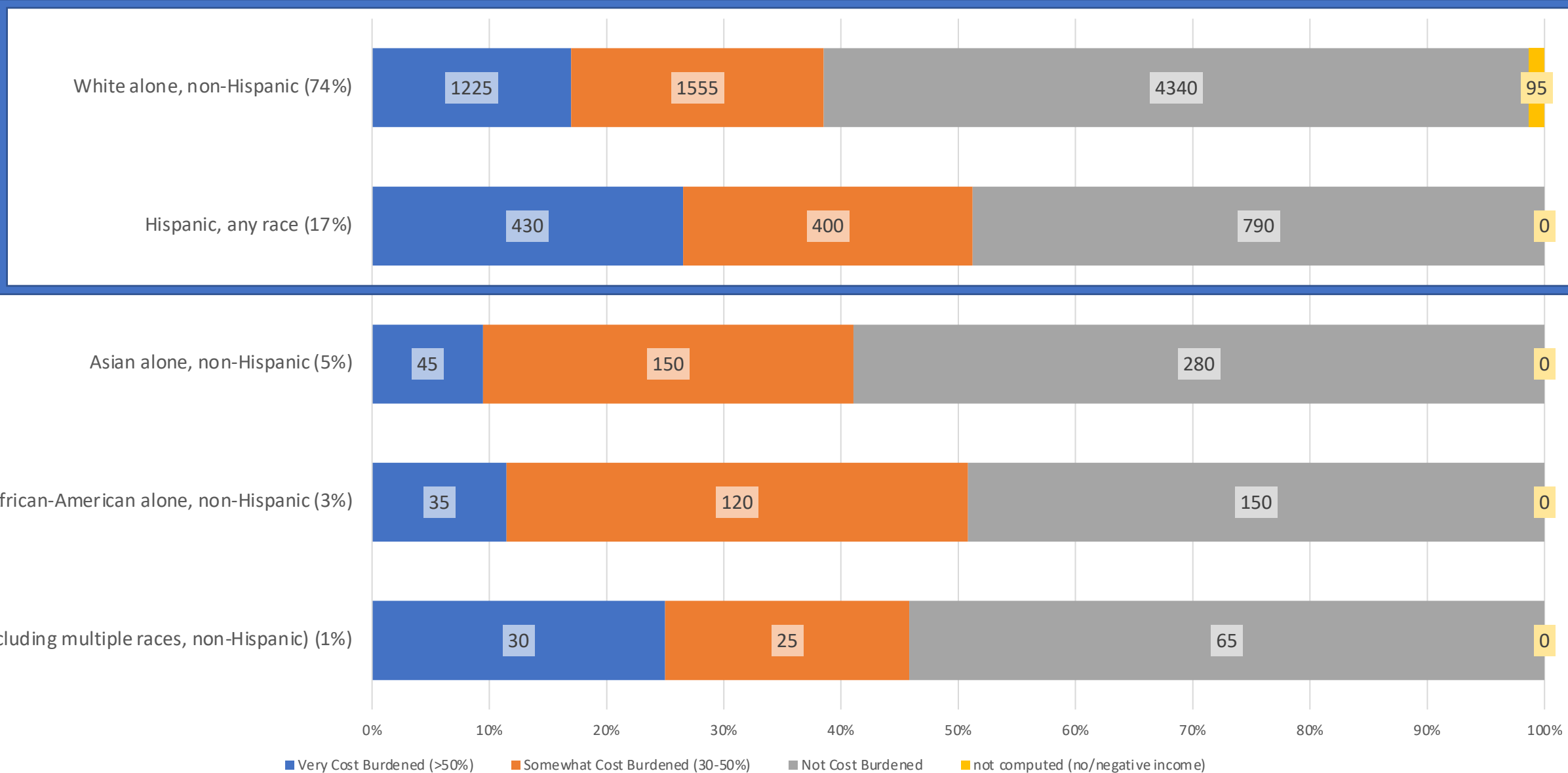

Homeownership Gap by Race

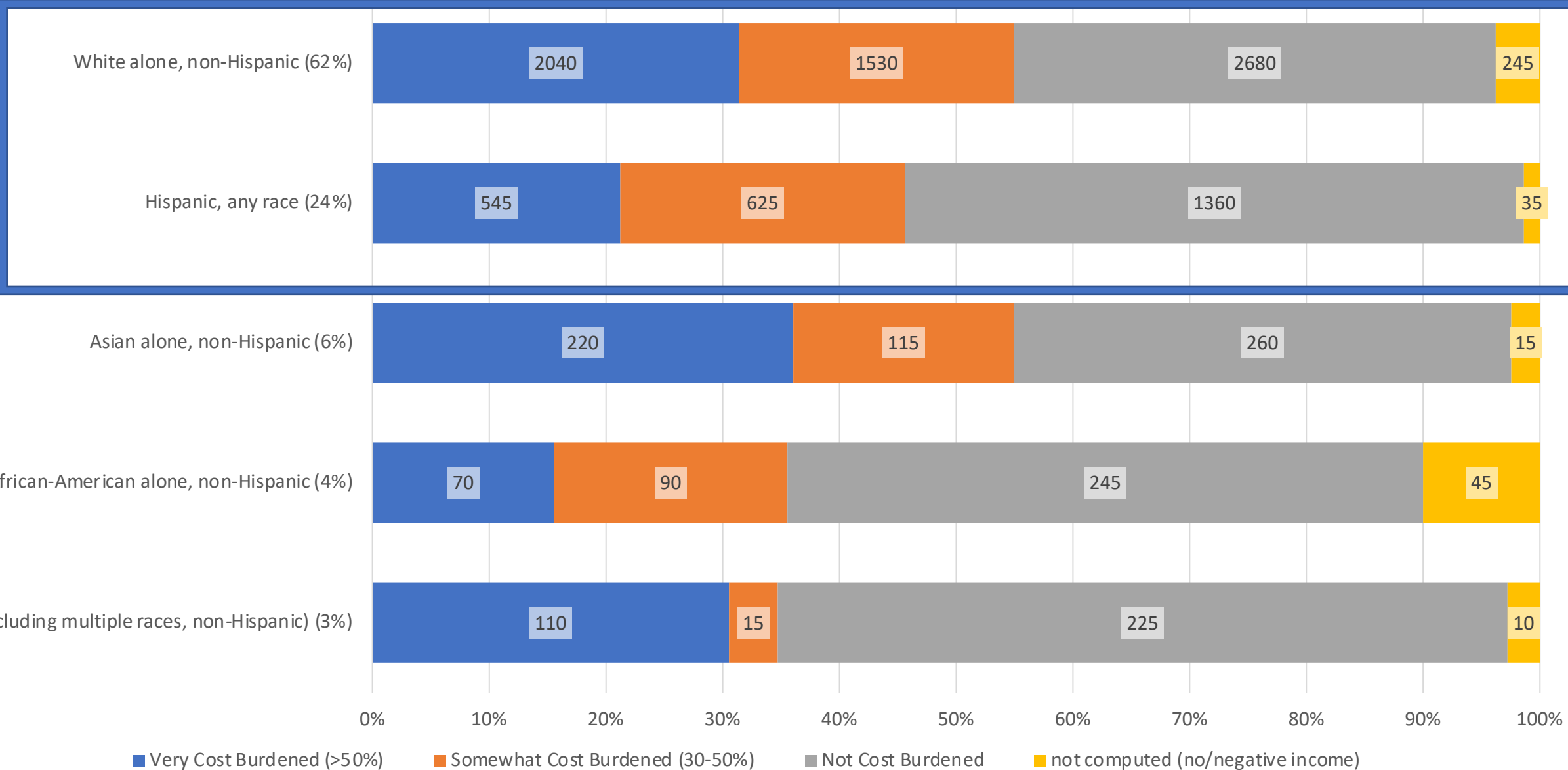

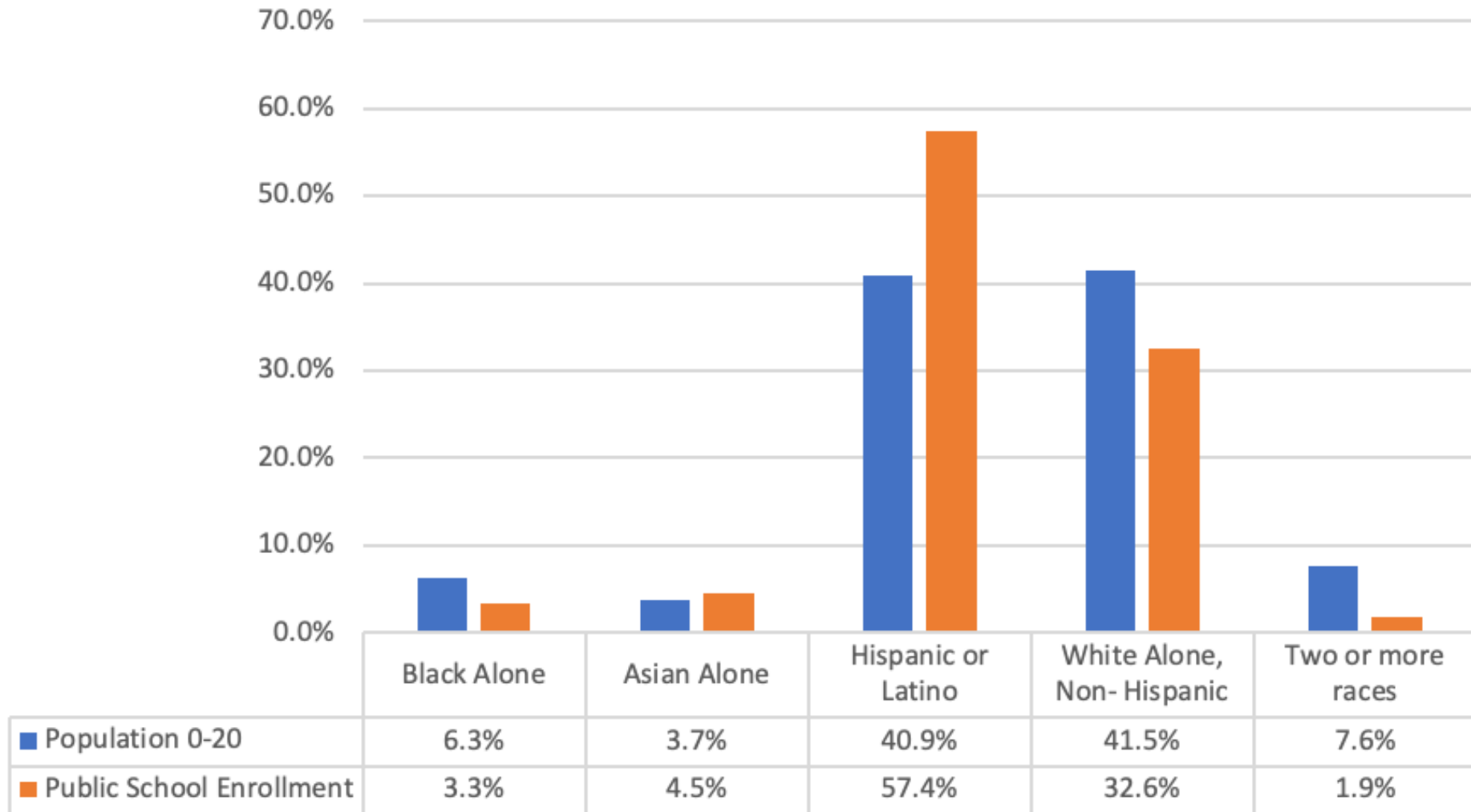
Housing Cost Burden for Homeowners



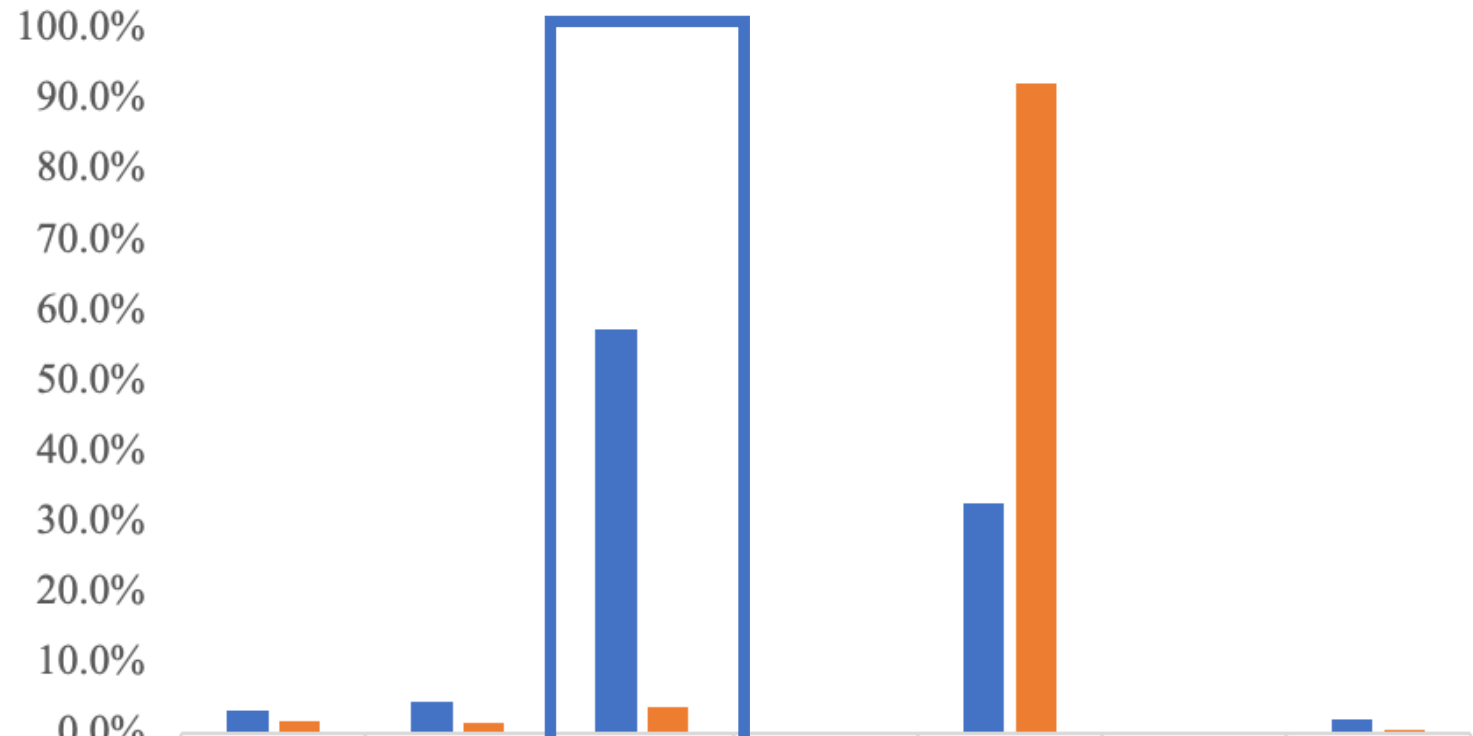
Housing Cost Burden for Renters
