Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a Public Hearing on January 23, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. in the City Councilor Joseph A. Del Grosso Council Chambers of Revere City Hall relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:

1. To amend Schedule IX of Title 10- Resident Parking Sticker Areas by adding:

Location	Direction	from	to	
a. Lawrence Rd	both	entire length		24-7
b. Leonard Rd	both	entire length		24-7
c. Revere St	southerly	North Shore Rd	Ocean Ave	24-7
d. Sears St	both	entire length		24-7

2. Amend Schedule XI of Title 10 Handicapped Persons Parking Areas by adding:

25 Norman St

22 Suffolk Ave

3. Amend Schedule VIII of Title 10 Parking Restrictions Generally by adding:

Sears St no parking on the odd side from Bay Rd to the dead end

4. Amend Schedule IV of Title 10 Isolated Stop Signs by adding:

- a. Malden St for east bound traffic at Newhall St
- b. Malden St. for westbound traffic at Newhall St.
- c. Newhall St for northbound traffic at Malden St.

Requests

1. Amend Schedule XI of Title 10 Handicapped Persons Parking Areas by adding:
 - 21 Kingman Ave
 - 128 Sigourney Street
 - 87 Revere Street.

2. The Mayor request the Traffic Commission to study the intersection of Linehurst Road and Agatha Street to determine the feasibility of replacing the DO NOT ENTER SIGN that previously faced Easterly toward the North Revere neighborhood. In recent years, heavy vehicles making deliveries to the plaza on Bennett Highway exit through the North Revere neighborhood instead of via Route 1, causing dangerous conditions for those who live in the neighborhood.

3. The Mayor request the Traffic Commission to study the intersection of Washington Avenue and Mountain Avenue to determine the feasibility of either a three-way STOP at this intersection or a similar course of action which would enable vehicles to safely turn on and off of Mountain Avenue.

4. Councilor Novoselsky requests the follow:
 - A. Request that Walnut Place be designated as Residential Permit Parking on southerly side
 - from Walnut Ave. to Sumner Street for 24 hours

 - B. Request that Woods have Residential Permit Parking on easterly side
 - from Revere Beach Parkway to Overlook Ave. hours be changed from

 - 24-hours to 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday

C. Request that the Revere Traffic Commission include in the Revere City Ordinances the prohibition and fining of parking within 10 feet of any crosswalk lines (either side) when not within the

20 feet from here to corner law.

5. Councilor Keefe request the Traffic Commission consider making the west side (no sidewalk side) of McCleavey Street “No Parking”.
6. The MBTA is requesting a public hearing regarding the following bus stops.
