Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1983, and Chapter 13 of the Acts of 1984, that the City of Revere Traffic Commission will conduct a public hearing on September 10, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. via remote participation only relative to the following proposed amendments to the parking and traffic regulations of the City of Revere:

1. Notice is hereby given that the City of Revere, through the Revere Traffic Commission, 281 Broadway, Revere, MA 02151 will hold a public hearing for the **PROPOSED** MBTA Sponsored Bus Only Lane Pilot Project. The Bus Only Lane Pilot will run from September 30th through December 31st, 2020 on the South Bound side of Broadway beginning from 730 Broadway southerly towards 80 Broadway onward to the Revere - Chelsea City Line. The pilot will operate during the hours of 4:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday beginning on September 30th to December 31st, 2020. Parking will be prohibited during the hours of 4:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. during the duration of the pilot in the south bound direction of Broadway. A parking penalty of \$100.00 will be imposed by the Revere Parking Department for vehicles parked in the bus lane during the pilot’s operating hours of 4:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday Friday from September 30th to December 31st, 2020, Revere City Ordinance Section 10.48.160 Title 10, Section 1 Parking Penalties. The proposed pilot is part of the MBTA’s response to improve bus service while promoting the health and safety of drivers and passengers during the COVID-19 Pandemic.
