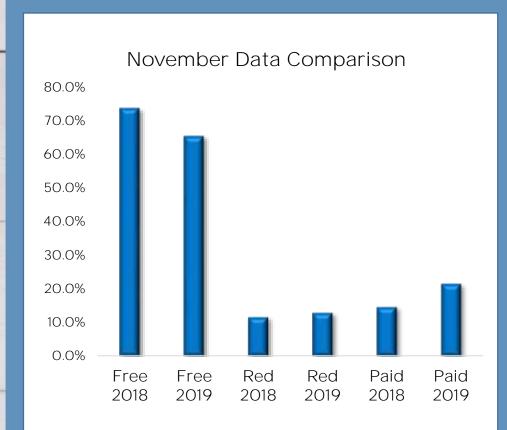

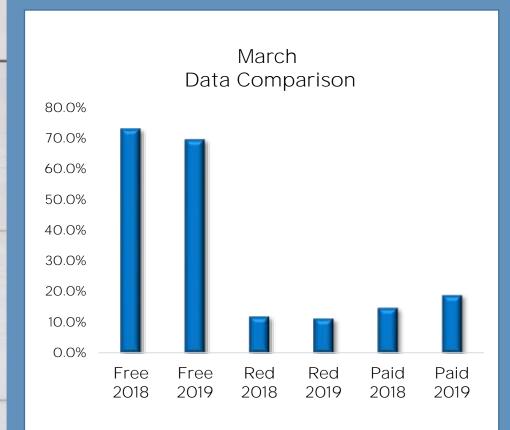

Daily Income Loss (based on 3k meals)

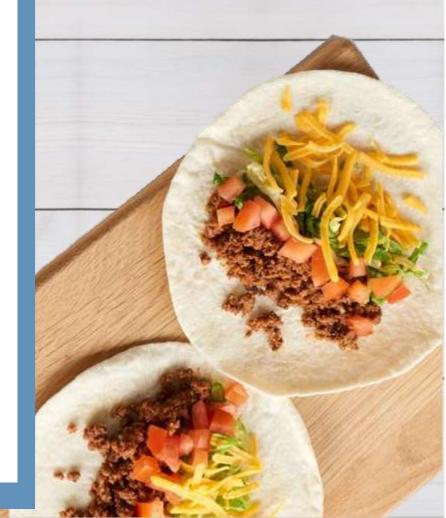
