- 19-230** Motion by Councillor Rotondo: That the Mayor request the Election Department to look into the feasibility of providing voters of Revere with an official voters ID.
- 19-241** Communication from Frank Ferrera, 204 Broadsound Avenue requesting information and clarification regarding the easement along the seawall at Roughan's Point.
- 19-242** Motion by Councillor Rotondo: That the Mayor request the State Police and or State Auditor to investigate the policy and procedure regarding the release of information from the Revere Police Department, in particular the release of a domestic event involving my children on October 2, 2012 in which Officer Soto and Duca were involved. The information was released on September 16, 2019 in an apparent attempt to discredit me publicly. I demand answer and I demand an investigation from an outside agency. If this can be done to a public official involving my children then it could be done to any member of the public.
