9. **23-098** Motion presented by Councillor Cogliandro: That the Acting Mayor direct the Chief of Police to increase patrols on True St. and Eastern Ave. The speeding issues have increased significantly on both streets in the last few months.

10. **23-099** Motion presented by Councillor Cogliandro: That the Acting Mayor direct the DPW to install speed radars, speed bumps, speed tables, or any mechanism that can stop speeding on True Street and Eastern Avenue.

11. **23-100** Motion presented by Councillor Cogliandro: That the Acting Mayor direct the Director of Parks and Recreation to allow the placement of a storage container at Ambrose Park for use by Revere Youth Soccer (RYS). RYS will pay for and build the storage container.
12. **23-101** Motion presented by Councillor Serino: That the Acting Mayor provide an update on the Council Order 22-255 that was approved on September 12, 2022, which read - That the Mayor direct the Police Department to utilize funds from the Dog Park Revolving Account to install a camera at the Paws 'N Play Dog Park on Sargent Street in West Revere due to serious issues relative to dogs being abandoned at the park, as well as dogs attacking other dogs and people.
13. **23-102** Motion presented by Councillor Serino: That the Acting Mayor provide an update on Council Order 22-326 that was approved on November 28, 2022, which read - That the Mayor request a representative from National Grid to appear before the Council to discuss the following outstanding requests for items in Ward Six - (1) Council Order 20-412, dated December 7, 2020 - Motion of Councillor Serino that National Grid add street lights to Pole Numbers 3960-50 and 3961-50 on Salem Street, opposite Overlook Ridge Drive; (2) Council Order 21-281, dated August 23, 2021 - Motion of Councillor Serino that National Grid install 96 watt street lamps on Poles 3960, 3960 1/2, and 3961 on Salem Street in North Revere, opposite the entrance to Overlook Ridge; and (3) Council Order 22-041, dated February 7, 2022 - Motion of Councillor Serino that National Grid install a street lamp on Pole 2793 in front of 58 Carlson Avenue.
14. **23-103** Motion presented by Councillor Cogliandro: That the Acting Mayor require all School Building Committee meetings to be broadcast live and saved on RevereTV's YouTube channel.
15. **23-104** Motion presented by Councillor Visconti: That the Acting Mayor request the CFO to present the City Council with a detailed reporting of the \$30 million of ARPA funds received by the City of Revere. The report shall include the total amount of ARPA monies spent, initiatives or programs that ARPA monies have been allocated to, and the remaining balance of ARPA monies.
16. **23-105** Motion presented by President Protempore McKenna: That the Acting Mayor request the DCR to investigate the feasibility of establishing a year-round beach dog park at the beginning of Revere Beach. This part of the beach is desolate and is never used by people even during the summer months. Cities and towns, all across Massachusetts, and other states offer these services at beaches for dog owners.
17. **23-106** Motion presented by President Protempore McKenna, Councillor Cogliandro: That the City Council award Certificates of Commendation to the Revere High School Robotics Team for placing second nationally.
18. **23-107** Motion presented by Councillor Cogliandro: That the Acting Mayor direct the DPW to conduct the following work at Ambrose Park: 1.) Install appropriate and sufficient signage indicating the field is usable by permit only; 2.) monitor the field more frequently for trash, add trash barrels, fill holes and add grass where needed.
