Project Overview

The City of Revere Water Replacement Project. The Engineering Department and Department of Public Works identified the need for water infrastructure improvements on Howard Street, Rand Street, McLeavy Street, and Oxford Street as well as intersections with Mountain Avenue, and Park Avenue. The City of Revere will be beginning a construction project in your neighborhood to improve the functionality and reliability of the water system by replacing the water main piping, hydrants, and valves.

Construction is scheduled to start September 2023

The water work will require several short-term water service interruptions to all buildings within the neighborhood, but long-term water service interruptions will be avoided through the installation of temporary water bypass. In order to take the existing water distribution system out of service to allow new water pipe and valve installation, the contractor will install temporary water mains above the ground along the proposed route of construction within the area of the included map. The temporary water mains will be installed, disinfected, and tested; then connected to each building or side street pipe abutting the limits of water bypass. Following completion of the water main installation in the street, the buildings will be reconnected to the buried water main in the street and the temporary water mains will be removed.

Location of Water Project Limits



The work hours for this effort is **7:00 am to 4:00 pm**. During this project, the area will be an active construction site and you should be careful and drive at a reduced speed accordingly. On the days when the Contractors are working, it is important not to have cars parked in the roadway. No parking signs will be posted in advance of construction and no-parking will remain in effect until construction is complete for that day. You will always have access to the street after work hours. **Be assured that access will always be available in your area for emergency services: ambulance, police, fire, DPW services and utility repair crews, and for the customers of and deliveries to businesses.** City services will continue throughout the construction period including snow removal, rubbish and recycle pick-ups, etc.

Police details will be present to assist everyone through the work zone and to facilitate traffic management.
