Application for Special Three-day Licenses for Malt/Wine, Common Vitualler, and Entertainment: Application of Black Marble Motorcycles, LLC d/b/a Boston Harley-Davidson, 649-1 Squire Road, for Special Three-day Licenses for Malt/Wine, Common Victualler and Entertainment, to be exercised at the same location, in the parking lot. Entertainment to include circus performers, face painting, DJ, bands, and motorcycle stunt drivers. Proposed dates are 5/15/2015 - 5/17/2015, with food and entertainment from 9 a.m. -7 p.m. and beer served from 11 a.m. -7 p.m.

Bill Peary and Peter DePesa appeared for the application. Mr. Peary is the event coordinator for Boston Harley-Davidson. Mr. DePesa, manager of The Squire, will be responsible for the alcohol service and sales at the event. The event is to be a grand opening celebration over the weekend, with expected crowds being anywhere from the hundreds on Friday, to the thousands on Saturday and Sunday. Police details have been obtained, and additional Harley-Davidson staff will be brought in from other stores to help with the event. Parking for motorcycles will be on site; car parking will be at the Showcase Cinemas parking lot next door, with people on hand to direct traffic. Alcohol sales will be conducted in a gated, fenced-off area, with ID checking and wrist IDs. It will be for beer only, and the beer will only be consumed within the designated area, which will have seating. The servers will be TIPS certified, and the manager will be on site at all times.

Upon a motion duly made by Commissioner LaCroix, and seconded by Vice Chairperson Guinasso, it was VOTED to approve the application.
