LICENSE RENEWALS

All Alcohol On-Premises

Four Partners, Inc. d/b/a Antonia's at the Beach, 492 Revere Beach Boulevard Off The Boat, Inc. d/b/a D'Amelio's Off The Boat Restaurant, 304-306 Revere Street

Deputy Fire Chief Paul Cheever reported on the inspection status of the two establishments, as follows:

- Four Partners, Inc. d/b/a **Antonia's at the Beach** had corrected their violations and passed inspection.
- Off The Boat, Inc. d/b/a **D'Amelio's Off The Boat Restaurant** had committed to an agreement with the Fire Department that would allow them to remain open with reduced hours and with seating kept within occupancy limits while they work on fulfilling their requirement to install a sprinkler system. This agreement was not yet signed, but the Fire Department was willing to approve a renewal, contingent upon finalizing the agreement.

Upon a motion duly made by Commissioner LaCroix, and seconded by Commissioner Guinasso, it was VOTED to approve the license renewal for Four Partners, Inc. d/b/a Antonia's at the Beach, 492 Revere Beach Boulevard.

Upon a motion duly made by Commissioner LaCroix, and seconded by Commissioner Guinasso, it was VOTED to approve the license renewal for Off The Boat, Inc. d/b/a D'Amelio's Off The Boat Restaurant, 304-306 Revere Street, contingent upon final approval by the Revere Fire Department.
