PHASE ONE

in order of priority

- CLINICAL AND NON-CLINICAL HEALTHCARE WORKERS DOING DIRECT AND COVID-FACING CARE
- LONG TERM CARE FACILITIES, REST HOMES AND ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES
- FIRST RESPONDERS (EMS, FIRE, POLICE)
- CONGREGATE CARE SETTINGS (INCLUDING CORRECTIONS AND SHELTERS)
- HOME-BASED HEALTHCARE WORKERS
- HEALTHCARE WORKERS DOING NON-COVID-FACING CARE

DECEMBER - FEBRUARY

PHASE TWO

in order of priority

- INDIVIDUALS WITH 2+ COMORBIDITIES AND/OR AGE 75+ (HIGH RISK FOR COVID COMPLICATIONS)
- EARLY EDUCATION AND K-12 WORKERS, TRANSIT, GROCERY, UTILITY, FOOD AND AGRICULTURE, SANITATION, PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC HEALTH WORKERS
- ADULTS 65+
- INDIVIDUALS WITH ONE COMORBIDITY

FEBRUARY-APRIL

PHASE THREE

VACCINE AVAILABLE TO
THE GENERAL PUBLIC

SCHEDULED TO START IN APRIL
