Project Overview

2023 Water Main Replacement

The City of Revere (City) and its consultants have identified locations throughout the City where water main infrastructure improvements are warranted. This work will consist of removing and replacing approximately 4,850 linear feet of aging water mains in the City along North Shore Road and surrounding streets. This replacement project will also include replacing hydrants, public side water services, and gate valves associated with these water mains. Maps depicting the approximate locations of these infrastructure improvements are provided.

Per MassDOT requirements, the work on North Shore Road will be performed overnight and there will be impacts to traffic patterns. Before construction begins, the contractor will provide additional informational fliers to residents who will be directly affected by this work.



The locations are as follows:

- Agawam Street
- Bellevue Avenue
- Calumet Street
- McKinley Street connection to Atwood Street
- North Shore Road (NB Lane)
- Wonderland Station Parking Lot
