



Job Title: Youth Career Pathway Instructor: Urban Forestry

Department: Community Development

Location: Location may vary throughout Revere

Hours: Variable up to 25 hours per week, may include nights and weekends

Salary: \$30 per hour, this is a temporary non-union position

Description: The Youth Career Pathway Instructor for Urban Forestry will lead a cohort of 5-6 youth involved in the youth summer job program. This is a new, temporary position created to expand the types of employment opportunities available for Revere youth beyond traditional office job environments. The specific interest to focus on urban forestry came from the role that the social determinants of health, existing inequities, and the urban environment resulted in the high rates of COVID19 in Revere. The instructor will be responsible for developing a curriculum and leading the day-to-day activities with the youth. Most of the lesson planning and curriculum development is expected to occur in June before the summer job program begins and it is anticipated that this position will oversee youth for an average of 20 hours a week, with an additional 5 hours available for ongoing lesson planning, during July and August 2022.

Desired Outcomes:

- Youth will gain a deeper understanding of the role the social determinants of health, particularly greenspace and the environment, played during the COVID19 pandemic in cities similar to Revere
- Youth will have an opportunity to participate in tree and flower plantings and city beautification efforts
- Youth will feel empowered to engage on other environmental justice issues impacting our community

Responsibilities:

- Curriculum development, consisting of hands-on activities including tree and flower plantings, upkeep, and beautification efforts; opportunities to learn about the role that green space and the urban environment connect to the social determinants of health, environmental justice, and community resiliency
- Develop supply list and navigate approval process for all materials with the Dept of Planning and Community Development

- Work with relevant departments/bodies on site selection
- Engage students in all levels of project development, from concept to completion
- Ensure project stays on track and within determined budget
- Communicate and collaborate with other City departments as needed
- Recruit guest speakers and arrange site visits
- Develop and submit reports as requested
- Create an equitable space for all youth involved in this program

Qualifications:

- 2+ years of relevant experience and overall comfort working with youth and young adults ages 16-21
- Background in community development or related field; specific experience in
- Strong problem solving and interpersonal skills
- Familiarity with municipal functions is a plus
- Demonstrated cultural competency, experience working with diverse communities
- Ability to manage project budgets, report on project deliverables
- Related experience with classroom instruction and group facilitation
- Means of transportation to visit worksites, pick up supplies
- Must pass CORI/SORI
