

I, William R. Gore of Weld, Franklin County, Maine, grant to Robin G. Jarvis of Auburn, Androscoggin County, Maine, my entire interest in a certain property situated in Wilton, County of Franklin and State of Maine, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set on the northwesterly side of U.S. Highway No. 2, one hundred fifty (150) feet northeasterly along the highway from another iron pin set at the easterly corner of land now or formerly of John P. Cullinan; and at the easterly corner of other land conveyed by Paul J. Beisaw and Sharyn A. Beisaw to John P. Cullinan; thence northwesterly along line of land conveyed to said Cullinan, the course passing through an electric power pole to a point marked by an iron pin on the southeasterly side of land now or formerly of Maine Central Railroad Company; thence northeasterly along the southeasterly side of land of said Maine Central Railroad Company one hundred fifty (150) feet to a point to be marked by another iron pin in the ground; thence southeasterly along line of land now or formerly of Arthur W. Beisaw and Ada B. Beisaw to a point marked by another iron pin set on the northwesterly side of U.S. Highway No. 2; thence southwesterly along the northwesterly side of the highway one hundred fifty (150) feet to the point of beginning, together with right in common with Arthur W. Beisaw and Ada B. Beisaw to pipe water from a well on the adjoining land now or formerly of John P. Cullinan and to enter the said Cullinan premises as reasonably necessary to view, maintain, and repair the well and pipeline.
