United Way of the Tri-Valley Area Don't Despair Car Repair Program

United Way has a goal to help our community become more mobile. That includes coordinating volunteer ride programs and providing help with car repairs. If you need assistance, please complete the form below.

Here are some things you need to know before completing the application:

- If approved, assistance will be provided up to \$1,000 per applicant.
- There can be only one applicant per household and an applicant may be funded only one time.
- If a car repair exceeds \$1,000 the applicant must secure the additional cost of the repairs prior to work starting. Proof of available funds beyond the \$1,000 must be sent to United Way in writing before work begins.
- If repair exceeds \$1,000, the payment of the customer portion must be paid to the garage prior to the work beginning. A receipt of payment must be provided to United Way by the garage.
- Applicants must be residents of Franklin County, Livermore or Livermore Falls.
- By submitting this application, the applicant understands that a committee of community members will be reviewing the application and the selected garage may be contacted for additional information.
- The garage completes page two of this form. It must be included with your application.
- Payment for the cost of the repair is sent directly to the garage, not the applicant.
- The United Way of the Tri-Valley Area is providing funding only and is not responsible for any future maintenance issues, damages or unfinished work.
