God has put before us a few medical needs and we are truly grateful to all who have sent in donations and continue to donate towards these needs. The little girl with Daniel had been hurt by a large rock. Her sponsor saw her soon after and immediately talked to mom about getting her to the clinic to get her infected hand treated. She did and this trip we got to see her totally healed.

The twin babies are also in great need. Their mom is young and has no help as both her parents have died. These babies have been congested and hungry and after a lot of prayer, talking to mom, trying to work through obstacles, we are doing what we can to help these children with food and medical help. If you would like to contribute please be sure to add a note so the office knows you are sending for medical help in Haiti. They are starting to put on weight and we'd love to see them healthy and mom learning how to care for them and loving doing so.

Love Kerly and Love Madalie are both sponsored. Their sponsors, team members, and others who have donated have helped these two young ones get treatment for their eyes, their infected skin, and now a bunk bed and mattresses to get them up off the dirt floor. The dirt floor is what is causing their rashes and skin infections. Their siblings will also be able to use this bed. Love Kerly now is pretty healthy and has eye glasses. Love Madalie will need eye surgery in a few short years when she's a bit older, but her skin is doing better with treatment as well. Please be praying for her that we will have the funds once it's time for surgery and it will give her a whole new life.

As one child or family is helped we celebrate with praises to the One who puts these before us and shows us how to help. Without Jesus we could never do this. Without our friends in country & the support of our sponsors/donors, we wouldn't know what is needed or how to proceed. God continues to awe us. We ask for your prayers and your help for these families. We can never say Thank You enough!
