About our trip: During the time of our visit, COVID-19 cases were rising in Honduras. Many of the churches were still not having service due to the pandemic. There was also a stay-at-home order starting at 10 pm. We were able to visit with all our partners and interviewed children and seniors in all the current programs. Most of the children have been able to continue with school online, with the exception of La Lima, where access to the internet is more difficult.

The programs continue to distribute the monthly provisions which have been of much help, especially during the pandemic. One senior in Rio Blanco expressed her gratitude and stated that the provisions were the only way she has made it through these trying times. La Lima was affected by the recent tropical storms that hit the country, but residents are slowly recovering. In Zolano, we got to visit with a senior who was celebrating her 97th birthday, and in Peñasquitos, the children shared a special dance with us. In total, we interviewed 208 children and 57 seniors.
