## \*\*\*\*\*Sponsorship Donations \*\*\*\*\*

This is a reminder that the sponsorship donation for a child in the Haiti program is \$120 for the year. This can be sent in as one full installment in January, monthly \$10 installments due by the 1st of each month, or as you can as long as each month's amount is in the office by the 1st of the month. When sponsorships are late then it hurts the children. We can't send yearly updates if sponsorship donations are not up-to-date.

If you are adding a child to your sponsorship then the amount is however many months are left in the year. Example: If you choose to sponsor a child in May then your sponsorship for that year, for that child, totals \$70 as that is seven months left in the year. If it is a replacement child for one who has left the program then the donations sent for the replaced child move to the replacement child.

Thank You to all of the sponsors that stepped up to the new Donation Amount in 2019 - which is already helping the children, families & schools.

### TERRIER ROUGE ~ HIS HOUSE

These two homes were built to house children who were in dire need of a place to live due to various reasons. It is a way for these children to be able to attend school every day, eat daily, and not be living on the streets or in other bad situations.

Donations have dwindled down so much that we're concerned they will have to close the doors and turn children away. One time donations are very welcome, but monthly donations are even a bigger help. 100% of your donation goes to the program of your choice. Other ways you can help the children in Haiti:

- 1. Saturday Feeding Program in Terrier Rouge: It takes at least \$50 to feed upwards of 200 children, many of whom may only get that one meal that week.
- 2. Kid for a Kid program: This is the goat program in Danda where a child/family is given a goat, taught how to care for and raise it, and the first offspring is given to another family.
- 3. Monetary gifts to your sponsored child and their family: Not only are you providing them with a means to get food and clothing, but you are helping their neighbors who sell the food and clothing. You're helping their economy get the boost that is needed!

If you have sent something to your sponsored child in Haiti up to this point please know it will still get to your child. If you have sent anything in the last several months to the school in Cap Haitien, under Pas Saintil's name via MFI, then please contact me at Lorna@hishandsforhaiti.org. The new info below is also on the information sheets as of May 2019.

For letters - Send letters to the address for His Hands Support Ministries listed on the first page. Please place each letter in a separate envelope addressed to the child, include their town of residence/school and a small photo and then put them all in one envelope addressed to His Hands.

For packages - Please place the items into a bag with your child's name, photo, and town of residence on the outside of the bag. Place the bag in a padded mailing envelope only (no boxes) and ship to His Hands Support Ministries at the address below. Please keep the weight to 5 pounds or less. We will take the packages on our twice yearly trips to Haiti.

For monetary gifts for your child - It is preferred that you send monetary gifts rather than items/packages. Monetary gifts we can send to Haiti several times a year and the family can use the money to buy what they really need and to help boost their economy. Monetary gifts need to go through the His Hands office.

Please add a note explaining the amount per child, giving the child's name, town of residence/school, and any other information you'd like us to pass on.
