GIFTS

We apologize, but we will not be able to get packages there until the next visit to Haiti. We don't want to discourage packaged gifts, but please know that by sending the children monetary gifts you are allowing the families to buy what is needed to sustain life, such as food, doctor visits, and medicine. At the same time you are helping their economy and at least one other family. When your child's family buys locally they are helping those who are selling. By helping a merchant you could be helping the farmer/ grower as well. It's a ripple effect.

As always, 100% of your gift donation goes to the child and family.

TERRIER ROUGE ~ HIS HOUSE

These two homes were built to house children who were in dire need of a place to live due to various reasons. It is a way for these children to be able to attend school every day, eat daily, and not be living on the streets or in other bad situations.

Donations have dwindled down so much that we're concerned they will have to close the doors and turn children away. One time donations are very welcome, but monthly donations are even a bigger help. 100% of your donation goes to the program of your choice. Please pray and consider giving, and share our website/FB page with your friends and family.

*****Sponsorship Donations*****

This is a reminder that the sponsorship donation for a child in the Haiti program is \$120 for the year. This can be sent in as one full installment in January, monthly \$10 installments due by the 1st of each month, or as you can as long as each month's amount is in the office by the 1st of the month. When sponsorships are late then it hurts the children. We can't send yearly updates if sponsorship donations are not up-to-date.

If you are adding a child to your sponsorship then the amount is however many months are left in the year. Example: If you choose to sponsor a child in May then your sponsorship for that year, for that child, totals \$70 as that is seven months left in the year. If it is a replacement child for one who has left the program then the donations sent for the replaced child move to the replacement child.

PLEASE note that even if your child has left the program between visits that your donation does not go to waste! It still helps the school to stay open so that other children can benefit!

Some of the benefits: children are given an education; children in schools with feeding programs receive a meal a day; it means a parent does not have to choose between feeding their family or sending a child to school.

Haiti Needs

Pastor Jodelin's church in Savane Carree is in need of funds to finish the church and the bathroom.

Pastor Noel's church in Terrier Rouge is in need of new benches.

Marie Noel loves to help all those in need around her with food and she can do this through the Saturday Feeding Program.

There are medical needs for children in the different communities we visit.

Please note the following:


For letters – Please place your letter in an envelope with the child's name, photo, and program name (Haiti) on it and then place that envelope in a larger envelope and address it with the address below.

For packages - Please place the items into a bag with your child's name, photo, and town of residence on the outside of the bag. Place the bag in a padded mailing envelope only (no boxes) and ship to His Hands Support Ministries at the address below. Please keep the weight to 3 pounds or less. We will take the packages on our twice yearly trips to Haiti.

For monetary gifts for your child - You may send financial gifts to the office with an explanation as to how you would like it used and we will forward it to our partners in Haiti. Please be sure to include a note explaining the amount per child, giving the child's name, and town of residence/school.
