



SCHOLARSHIP POLICIES

In an effort to fulfill our mission, the State YMCA of Maine strives to provide services to all regardless of ability to pay. While the YMCA sets fees at affordable rates, scholarship funds are available to those who need additional assistance to make the YCamp Experience possible. Assistance is awarded according to each applicant's ability to pay and the funds available.

Financial assistance does not cover 100% of the costs. Any remaining tuition balances must be paid in full prior to the beginning of your camper's first session.

Eligibility

Scholarship awards are based on household income, number of campers enrolled, and the total program tuition costs. Changes in enrollment will affect awards and overall tuition balances. Applicants are required to pay a deposit of \$50 per registered week per camper.

Application Process

- All applications for financial assistance remain confidential.
- Applications for financial assistance are available by contacting YMCA Camp of Maine and on the website (www.maineycamp.org).
- Verifiable documentation of income and expenses must accompany the application in order for it to be processed.
- Please see instructions on the application. If you are exempt from paying taxes, send verification of income received from federal, state or local agencies.
- After the Scholarship Committee has completed their review, a letter will be sent informing you of their award.
