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Highlights from the Last Four Months (November 2021 – February 2022)

1. A new addition to our service portfolio

a. Telephones

Support for desk-based telephones has moved to the Technology Department. This shift represents a natural transition as district phones are largely VoIP (voice over Internet Protocol) phones, which connect to our network.

2. Infrastructure upgrades update

a. Firewalls

We've selected a vendor for our firewall replacement project, and will move forward this spring to begin those upgrades. Federal E-Rate funding will cover over half the cost of the new hardware. This project will help us better identify, and respond to, digital threats outside and inside our network.



b. Wifi access points (APs)

We've expanded the density of our Wifi APs around the district to better support the Wifi needs of students, teachers, and staff.

3. Staffing update

a. Department reorganization

To better serve the technology needs of students, staff, and families, we undertook the process of examining and changing the department organization. This reorganization has allowed us to decrease response times and increase coverage for all operational aspects of technology around the district.

b. New staff members

We are excited to welcome Amos Doughty and Dakota Wilson to our team as district technicians. Both team members come to Mt. Blue Regional School District with many years of technical experience and a focus on customer service and support.

4. Technology Professional Development (PD) and Training


a. Calendar
