2020 - 2021 School Year in Review

- . Academy Hill was the first school to have a positive COVID case. Our school staff along with the district and school nurses responded quickly and effectively.
- . The Wilton schools only went full remote one time due to cases outside of our schools.
- . 1 to 1 iPads were provided for every student and teacher.
- . Office Discipline Referrals decreased from 330 in 2019-20 to 56 in 2020-21 at AHS and from 261 in 2019-20 to 23 in 2020-21 at Cushing.
- . At the beginning of the school year at AHS we had 137 hybrid students and 1 full time. At the end of the school year we had 135 hybrid students and 6 full time.
- At Cushing we started with 79 hybrid students and ended with 81 hybrid and 6 full time students.
- . We were able to have our end of the year field day at both schools.
- . Our teachers provided our 5th graders with a drive by end of the year celebration.





What We Learned

- . Teamwork, communication, and flexibility will help you adapt and overcome any obstacle.
- . Smaller classes make a big difference for all students academically, socially and behaviorally.
- . Teachers can be very creative in delivering Instruction.
- . Students and staff rocked the masks.
- . Staff who thought they were not technologically savvy learned and did awesome things with it.
- . Students are much more resilient than what we think they might be.

ASSESSMENTS

- . Our Star 360 MATH Scores showed an 8% increase from 42% to 50% (fall to spring) in the number of students who showed proficiency in the Star 360 math assessment.
- . Our Star 360 READING Scores showed a 10% increase from 42% to 52% (fall to spring) in

the number of students who showed proficiency in the Star 360 math assessment.
