

ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT

The Board of Directors endorses the concept of offering programs to meet the needs of students of all ability levels. To do this, it may be necessary for students to enroll at a college or university prior to the completion of a four-year high school program. The following types of programs are approved by the Board:

A. **Advanced Placement.** This program allows students to enroll at a post-secondary institution to take courses while still taking most course work at Mt. Blue High School. (This credit is also applied to the student's high school transcript.) This provides a student with the opportunity to earn college credits outside his/her academic day.

B. **Early Admissions Program.** This program is designed for students who exhibit superior achievement in high school and who do not wish to return to high school as a senior. Successful completion of the freshman year at a college or university fulfills the requirements for graduation from Mt. Blue High School.

C. **Alternative Placement Program.** This program allows a student who is academically capable, to enroll in a post-secondary education program for the last semester of the senior year while retaining his or her status as a senior at Mt. Blue High School.
