

CLASS SIZE

The Board of Directors will strive to maintain the class size that it deems appropriate for the effective instruction of pupils in accordance with financial realities. The Board of Directors recognizes that greater direct teacher contact with pupils is a positive aspect toward the educational growth of children. The Board of Directors will seek to strike a balance in class size with its ability to finance a higher level of instructional expenditures.

The Board directs the Superintendent to work with Principals in establishing a reasonable and equitable class enrollment for each teacher. When at all possible, class sizes shall be consistent within a grade level and/or subject area.
