

ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Tuition Students

It is the general policy of Mt. Blue Regional School District not to admit non-resident tuition students. Effective July 1, 1989 and thereafter, new non-resident tuition students shall be admitted only by advance written approval of the Superintendent, copy to the Board of Directors.

Employees of Mt. Blue Regional School District

Persons who are employed by Mt. Blue Regional School District for more than fifty percent (50%) of the work year are eligible to apply to the Superintendent to have their children admitted to Mt. Blue Regional School District on a tuition-free basis.

Application Process

All requests for admission of non-resident students shall be forwarded to the Superintendent of Schools before a non-resident student is admitted to any Mt. Blue Regional School District school. The Superintendent's office shall make all final determinations concerning such requests.

Seniors

Students who are seniors at Mt. Blue High School, shall be allowed to complete the school year on a tuition-free basis if their family moves out of Mt. Blue Regional School District after the student's junior year and if the student remains in good academic and behavioral standing.
