**Citizens of the District are welcome at all meetings of the Board. Those who attend the Board meetings will be given an opportunity to express their thoughts. Unless unusual circumstances exist, the Board will not take action at the meeting when a new item for consideration is brought to the Board's attention. It is the intent of the Board to have such items, when appropriate, placed on a future agenda for consideration and possible Board action.**
