- Provide direct behavioral consultations and interventions for students in the Pathway For All Learners Program (PAL) – anticipated grades 3-5
 - Excellent skills crafting Positive Behavior Plans and Functional Behavioral Assessments.
 - Effective communication and interpersonal skills.
 - Experience with school based behavioral interventions and planning.
 - Work collaboratively with school personnel, families and outside agencies as necessary to develop and implement behavioral interventions.
 - Provide professional development to district and building level staff.
 - Model teaching strategies and work with teachers in classroom settings focusing on implementation of positive behavior intervention and support strategies.
 - Perform Functional Behavior Assessment and Comprehensive Evaluation with emphasis and focus on best practice to support behavioral change.
 - Provide consultation services to staff.
 - Attend solution-seeking meetings regarding behavioral needs/interventions, as needed
 - Work collaboratively with school staff to improve behavior management systems.
 - Work with the team to train staff using the current intervention system
