Mt. Blue Regional School District was notified today that **one** (1) person associated with our district has tested positive for COVID-19. Contact tracing is complete and **24** close contacts were identified; all close contacts have been contacted. The number of cases and the impacted school(s)/location(s) are included below.

As a result, due to the impact on staffing, the 8th grade Saddleback Community at Mt. Blue Middle School will be in a full remote model from Monday, 4/12 through Friday, 4/16. Please know that our schools are safe, and they continue to be cleaned per CDC guidelines. Teachers will be in touch with students via email and Google Classroom. Saddleback students will return to their regular schedule on Monday, 4/26 (after April break). Our hybrid model of instruction is not impacted for any other communities at Mt. Blue Middle School, and those students should report to school as normally scheduled.
